On Saturday, October 15th, Geneseo played host to the recently formed Northern Illinois Big-12 Conference Cross-Country Meet. The league is the premier 2A cross-country conference in the state of Illinois and featured 6 of the top 15 ranked teams in the girls' race and 4 of the top 15 teams in the boys' race. To say the least, the competition was fierce. It was a tremendous honor for the Leafs to play host and a special thanks goes out to the many parent and faculty volunteers who helped pull off the highly successful endeavor. In addition, the weatherman also was kind to us with a daytime high of 58 degrees. However, the wind was a major factor with a steady westerly wind of 15 mph with gusts up to 25 mph. The times that were put down in that kind of wind were staggering to say the least. The NIB-12 will certainly be well represented at the state meet. The quality of the programs is of the highest level and the professionalism of each coaching staff is to be envied and respected. Each team competed at the highest level and role modeled true sportsmanship and an intense level of competition.

The Varsity Girls got things rolling at 10:00 am. As mentioned above, the field was absolutely loaded as evidenced by Emily Ford smashing the school record and placing only 11th. Our girls almost all ran lifetime bests on the challenging Richmond Hill course. When the dust had settled and the scores were calculated, a few heads were facing downward in disappointment with the 6th place finish. That is an understandable reaction and we will have to raise the bar to realize the dream of running in this year's state finals. With that being said, we are very proud of the efforts that our ladies put forth. Hosting championship meets is both a blessing and a curse due to meet

management responsibilities. Emily did a great job of going with the talented lead pack. Eleventh place wasn't what she was hoping for but it did earn her first team All-Conference honors. Rookie surprise Maggie Schlindwein, Morgan Kelly, Katie Lynch, Amber Fobert, and Sarah Dellett closed the scoring with 36th, 37th, 43rd, 44th, and 45th place showings. Great job, Ladies.

Next up were the Varsity Boys who were running their second race without senior Tri-Captain Kyle Reiling who has been given medical clearance to resume training following three weeks on the bike. The news came on Friday and appeared to energize the team as they came ready to race hard. Sixth place in that field without Kyle was a tremendous accomplishment. The team was led by Jordan Starkey's 6th place effort which earned him first team All-Conference honors for the second straight year. Jordan's effort resulted in the Leafs' only medal in the talented field but the efforts from the other six Maple Leafs were top notch. Mitchell Lawson continued his phenomenal improvement with a tremendous 27th place effort and a huge Personal Best on the Richmond Hill course. The biggest surprise was turned in by senior Tri-Captain Dan Hanford who ended up as the team's 3rd man with his 31st place effort and monster Personal Best. Mitchell Lamb, David Chenoweth, Sean Lillis, and Marcus Gagnon closed the scoring with 36th, 37th, 38th, and 46th place efforts. Job well done, Men.

Geneseo 6th at NIB12 boys' and girls' cross country meets

GENESEO — The Northern Illinois Big 12 cross country meet, arguably the strongest 2A conference in the state for the sport, provided Geneseo with a strong test heading into the postseason.

Though placing sixth out of 12 teams, the Maple Leafs came away from the event, held at Richmond Hill Park in Geneseo, quite pleased.

Without Kyle Relling, one of its two best runners, after he suffered a broken wrist in a marching band accident three weeks ago, Geneseo stood up to the competition, a field with four of the top 15 teams in the state. They finished in the middle of the pack with 137 points, trailing state-power Yorkville (40), DeKalb (94), Kaneland (98), Sycamore (116), and Dixon (119).

"This is a phenomenal field—it's absolutely loaded," Geneseo coach Don Fredericks said. "It's a bit of a disadvantage hosting the event from a coaching standpoint, but its great for the kids and for the parents to not have to travel to another community. There's a lot of support out here."

The Maple Leafs were led by their other top runner, Jordan Starkey, who performed exceptionally well in the windy conditions. He finished in a team-best sixth place out of 81 boys with a time of 16:35.30. Having the spotlight to himself was a challenge he took head-on, giving him a strong effort heading into next Saturday's Galesburg Regional, where Geneseo will have Relling back.

"The wind was definitely a factor, going up those hills," Starkey said. "But overall, I felt good throughout the entire race. Getting Kyle back will be huge for us."

"Jordan had the race of his life," added Fredericks.

Dixon's Simon Thorpe won the race, crossing the finish line at 16:01.60, almost 11 seconds ahead of runner-up Marc Dubrick of DeKalb. Other top Maple Leafs finishers were Mitchell Lawson (27th, 17:29.84) and Dan Hanford (31st, 17:42.21).

Like the boys, the Geneseo girls finished in sixth with 142 points in the 12-team field that included an astounding six teams ranked in the top 15 in the state. Yorkville came out victorious, with 32 points, including four runners in the top 8. Trailing Yorkville were Kaneland (61), DeKalb (72), Dixon (101) and Sycamore (136).


Emily Ford had the lowtime for Geneseo, placing 11th, sneaking onto the 11girl all-conference team. Ford ran the race in 19:29.71, about 51 seconds behind the winner, DeKalb's Kelsey Schrad-


er (18:38.46).

"It was a tough course, and it's pretty cold out," Ford said. "This meet has some really good competition. Even though I didn't place where I wanted to, I'm still confident. I think we are all peaking at the right, lowering our times."

"It was a tough race for Emily," Fredericks said. "She's competing against five all-staters out there. I know she hoped she'd finish with a little higher place, but she made first-team (all-conference). It was a gutsy performance."

Finishing four spots behind Ford was fellow Maple Leaf Paige Gatter, who finished with a time of 19:55.01, good for 15th place. Other notable Geneseo runners were Maggie Schlindwein (36th) and Morgan Kelly (37th).









DAN HANFORD tries to keep pace with the lead pack at the NIB 12 Conference Meet Oct. 15.


