LEAFS GRAB 4TH AND 6TH IN RUGGED NIB-12 MEET

On Saturday, October 13, the Leafs traveled to Peru to participate in the Northern Illinois Big 12 Conference Cross Country Meet. The league is considered to be the toughest 2A Conference in the entire state and it lived up to its billing. Unfortunately, the weatherman wasn't very kind to us and nailed us with a lot of rain and wind. Luckily, the lightning stayed away for the meet so we didn't experience any weather delays. Meet administration also combined the F/S and Open races so that both the girls and boys ran together in separate races. The end result was four races (Girls and Boys Varsity Races were run separately) over the course of two hours. LaSalle-Peru High School played host and did an excellent job of Meet Administration under adverse conditions. The meet was held at Baker Lake Park in Peru.

The Varsity Girls got things rolling at 9:00 am and actually got to enjoy the day's best conditions (not all that great but it got worse as the day continued.) Defending State Champion, Number One state-ranked, and nationally-ranked Yorkville dominated the race with 5 of the top 9 places. The Lady Leafs mixed it up well and ended up tying for 4th (won on the 6th runner). The girls had one All-Conference Runner in Emily Ford who ran to 11th place in the hotly contested race. Kaneland (ranked 3rd in the state) placed 2nd with DeKalb grabbed 3rd. The Lady Leafs closed their scoring with Halle Olson (26th), Lauren Coulter (27th), Maggie Schlindwein (31st), and Taylor Claus in 34th place. Katie Puls and Morgan Kelly rounded out the top 7 with 35th and 38th place finishes. Solid efforts Ladies. Dry off and get ready to make a run towards Detweiller Park and the State Finals in the coming weeks.

The Varsity Boys were up next and also battled a powerhouse field. When the dust had settled, they had placed a respectable 6th as a team and had two team members earn All-Conference Honors. Seniors Jordan Starkey and Mitchell Lawson placed 6th and 21st respectfully to earn All-Conference. Well done, Men. Rounding out the Leaf scoring were youngsters Nick Fox (31st) and David Chenoweth (32nd) who had the exact same times and Junior Tony Gatter who placed a strong 44th overall. Completing the team effort were Mitchell Lamb and Chaise Blakley who placed 46th and 50th respectfully. The weather took a turn south during this race and Da Leafs never backed down. Becca Rapps led the way with a strong 2nd place finish (she led the race for a LONG TIME.) Not far behind were: Jenna Freebern, Madison Miller, Molly Lembke, and Olivia Carroll who placed 5th, 8th, 9th, and 15th overall. When the points were added up we were tied with national powerhouse Yorkville with 38 points each. The 6th runner broke the tie and luckily for us, Callie Miller and Lindsey Bideaux rolled home in 19th and 20th while Yorkville's 6th runner placed 21st. Great job, Ladies with a TOTAL TEAM EFFORT!

The F/S boys put two Leafs into the top 21 to earn All-Conference honors and lead the team to a respectable 6th place team finish. Freshman Charlie Elden and sophomore Nolan Fassett led the way with strong 11th and 12 place finishes in the driving rain. Closing out our team scoring were: Gabe Johnson (30th), Hunter Grau (43rd), and Josiah Cropp (45th.) Girls fourth, boys sixth in NIB 12 Conference

Battling very wet, rainy and windy conditions, plus a tough field of runners at the NIB 12 Cross Country Conference Meet Oct. 13 at LaSalle-Peru, the Geneseo girls captured fourth and the boys took sixth.

"We were certainly hoping for higher than that, but it is what it is, and it was extremely competitive," said head coach Don Fredericks. "I thought we ran pretty well. Our kids did a good job of making the best out of a very trying situation."

"The F/S girls and girls in the open race won their division and that was pretty exciting, which shows a lot of our depth."

Emily Ford led the Geneseo girls with an 11th-place finish in 19 minutes and 1 second.

Halle Olson took 26th in 19:59, followed by Lauren Coulter, 27th, 20:02; Maggie Schlindwein, 31st, 20:15; Taylor Claus, 34th, 20:26; Katie Puls, 35th, 20:28; and Morgan Kelly, 38th, 20:51.

Jordan Starkey cracked the Top 10 in the varsity boys' race in sixth place with a time of 15:39 to lead the way.

Mitchell Lawson came in 21st in 16:12, followed by Nick Fox, 31st, 16:43; David Chenoweth, 32nd, 16:43; Tony Gatter, 44th, 17:18; Mitchell Lamb, 46th, 17:19; and Chaise Blakley, 50th, 17:23.

"We had three make All-Conference, Emily Ford, Jordan Starkey and Mitchell Lawson," said Fredericks. "Mitchell ran the race of his life to get 21st. He fought really hard and it was awesome to see him accomplish that."

Olivia Carroll came in 14th, 22:33; Callie Miller, 19th, 22:41; and Lindsey Bideaux, 20th, 22:42.

Geneseo freshmen/sophomore boys placed sixth overall. Competing for the boys were Charley Elden, 11th, 17:56; Nolan Fassett, 12th, 18:00; Gabe Johnson, 30th, 18:49; Josiah Cropp, 45th, 19:57; Keegan Banister, 47th, 20:04; and Raul Falcon, 55th, 21:04.

Geneseo's girls who teamed up in the open race also nabbed the conference title behind Jessa Coulter, second, 20:39; Kylie Lembke, fourth, 21:10; Sarah Dellett, 10th, 22:08; Dani Manna, 11th, 22:08; Caitlin Akers, 23:46; Courtney Backes, 21st, 23:51;

Amber Fobert, 22nd, 23:51; Jeni Bergles, 25th, 24:03; Rachel Ganson, 35th, 26:26; and Savannah Chapman, 42nd, 28:03.

In the boys' open race, the Leafs took fourth place with finishes from Marcus Gagnon, 17th, 18:23; Bryce Gramling, 22nd, 18:53; Josh Dodge, 34th, 19:44; Sam Alexander, 35th, 19:46; Hunter Kuffel, 40th, 20:22; Karl Flynn, 45th, 20:50; Tom Jackson, 50th, 21:08; Sean Pemble, 21:34; Blake Lyon, 57th, 22:39; Christoph Stemmermann, 23:34; and Michael Neuwohner, 60th, 23:38.

Both Geneseo squads will be in action at 10 a.m. Oct. 20 in the Galesburg Regional.

"Regionals will be a ferocious competition and it is going to be a challenge, but it will help prepare us for sectionals," said Fredericks. "I want to see us advance and line up a week from this Saturday at the sectional with a goal to qualify for state."
