
Geneseo Cross Country Places Tenth in District

The first five individual runners plus members of the first and second place teams qualify for the State meet which will be run at 10 next Saaturday morning over a course on University of Illinois golf course at Savoy.

Smith, the strong Maroon. senior, was the easy winner for individual laurels as he traversed the hilly course in a swift 14:07.3. Smith finished a few hundred yards ahead of the field as the expected duel between Smith and Princeton's

Finishing sixth was Robert Seeds of Moline, and the remainder of the first 10 finishers were Ken Enstrom of Rock Island, Mike Diestelmeier of Freeport, Tom Lawrence of Sterling and Larry Jones of East Moline.

Then came Freeport with 104. Mount Morris with 134, Moline with 153, Sterling with 154, Princeton with 186, Dixon with 211, Rock Falls with 227 and

Geneseo with 235.

Joining Begyn and Enstrom on Rock Island's winning team were Tony Canny (11th), Ted Larson (22nd), Jerry Greenleaf (23rd), Robert Bellamy (26th) and Tom Farrar (45th).

Teammates of Jones for East Moline were Charles Luebke (15th), Alvino Terronez (20th), Gary Andress (24th), Terry Erickson (33rd), James Clark Larry Jones of East Moline.
