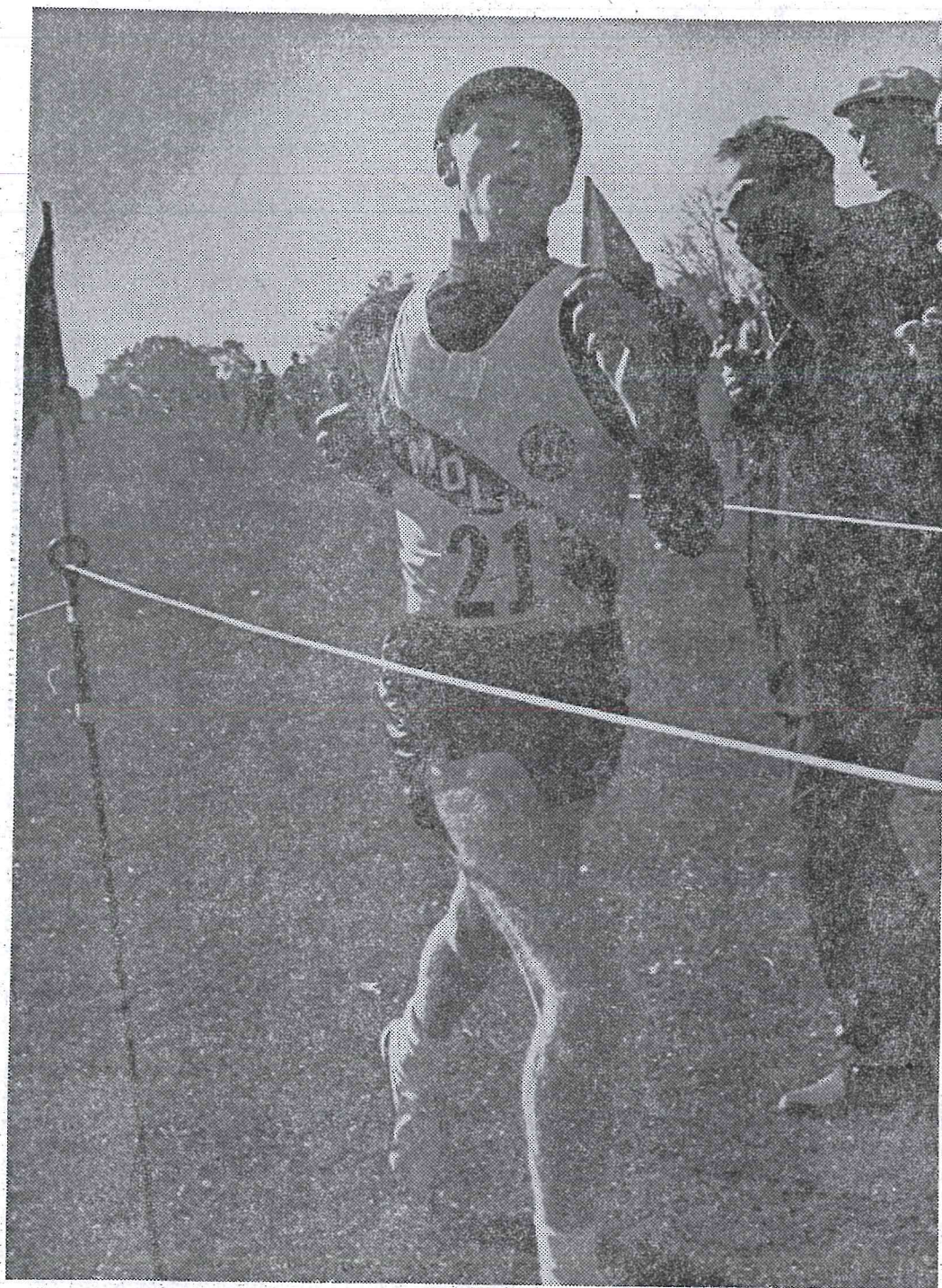


Geneseo Cross Country Places Tenth in District

Geneseo's cross country team placed 10th in the state district meet held last Saturday at the Indian Bluffs golf course in Moline. The winner was Rock Island with 65 points.

Other schools placing were East Moline 102, Freeport 104, Mt. Morris 134, Moline 153, Sterling 154, Princeton 186, Dixon 211, Rock Falls 227, and Geneseo 235.

Placing for the Leaf runners were Scott Lodge 12, Randy Pobanz 28, Tom Todd 50, Mike Hemmingson 65, Dave Weber 80, Mark Wiedenhoef 96, and Joe Garrity 107.

Moline's Smith, Rocks Claim Harrier Crowns

Moline's Duane Smith won individual honors and Rock Island took the team championship in the district cross country meet Saturday over a 2.75-mile course in Indian Bluff Forest Preserve.

East Moline finished second to Rock Island in team standings and also qualified its team for next Saturday's State Cross Country Meet to be run at Savoy, near Champaign. It was one of East Moline's best performances in cross country.

The first five individual runners plus members of the first and second place teams qualify for the State meet which will be run at 10 next Saturday morning over a course on University of Illinois golf course at Savoy.

Smith, the strong Maroon senior, was the easy winner for individual laurels as he traversed the hilly course in a swift 14:07.3. Smith finished a few hundred yards ahead of the field as the expected duel between Smith and Princeton's

Tom Swan, last spring's state mile champion, failed to materialize.

Instead, Smith's closest pursuer was another Quad-City runner, Larry Begyn of Rock Island, who wound up second. Swan placed third and was followed by Darrell Robinson and Scott Rosenbalm, both of Mount Morris.

Finishing sixth was Robert Seeds of Moline, and the remainder of the first 10 finishers were Ken Enstrom of Rock Island, Mike Diestelmeier of Freeport, Tom Lawrence of Sterling and Larry Jones of East Moline.

In team standings, Rock Island had low score of 65 points

and East Moline was runnerup with 102.

Then came Freeport with 104, Mount Morris with 134, Moline with 153, Sterling with 154, Princeton with 186, Dixon with 211, Rock Falls with 227 and Geneseo with 235.

Joining Begyn and Enstrom on Rock Island's winning team were Tony Canny (11th), Ted Larson (22nd), Jerry Greenleaf (23rd), Robert Bellamy (26th) and Tom Farrar (45th).

Teammates of Jones for East Moline were Charles Luebke (15th), Alvino Terronez (20th), Gary Address (24th), Terry Erickson (33rd), James Clark (48th) and Ronald Ramirez (53rd). The first five finishers are counted for each team.
