Maroon Harriers Win District

KEWANEE — Moline's powerful cross - country team claimed another host of victims Tuesday when it placed all five runners in the top ten and easily won the District meet here.

Maroon Steve Decker in a Moline; Jay Himegarner, Yates City; Doug Hill, Galesburg; Jim Moline's Dave Howell was Libby, Moline; Larry Ballageer, third, followed by Gail Trulson, East Moline and Dave Van Galesburg; Pat Eberhart, Vooren, Moline.

So the Maroons who totalled 28 points, along with the other teams in the top five of the 18-school meet — Rock Island, 76; Galesburg, 91; East Moline, 143; and Kewanee, 156 — will advance to the Sectional next week in Peoria. The state finals will be held in Peoria, Nov. 4.

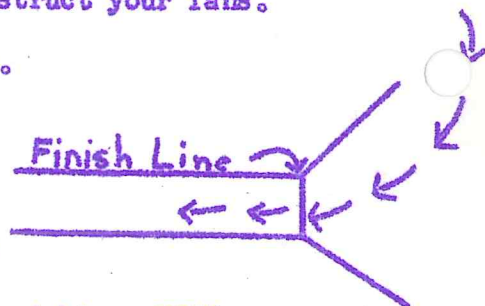
ILLINOIS HIGH SCHOOL ASSOCIATION DISTRICT

EACH TEAM IS TO REPORT TO THE CLERK OF THE COURSE IMMEDIATELY UPON ARRIVAL AT COURSE.
Clerk of course - Ken Vincent, Kewanee

INSTRUCTION DATA:

1. Since we have no locker space available, teams are requested to come dressed in running equipment.
2. Contestants may warm up on the course.
3. Spikes or rubber sole shoes may be worn.
4. Colored shirts must be worn by all contestants.
5. Numbers must be worn on BOTH the FRONT and the BACK of each contestant.
6. No one but runners will be permitted on course. STAY OFF THE GREENS AND OUT OF SAND TRAPPS. Any boy running on a golf green will automatically disqualify his team.
7. NO SPECTATORS ON THE COURSE AT ANY TIME! Please so instruct your fans.
8. There will be one tour of the course at 3:00 P.M. only.
9. Contestants will line up at 3:45 P.M.
10. Race will start promptly at 4:00 P.M.
11. Finish line will be narrow part of chute as outlined.
12. Flags designate the following: RED - left YELLOW - right BLUE - straight ahead
13. Awards will be presented at conclusion of the event.
14. Distance will be 2.97 miles.
15. The course will be completely marked by 2 white chalk lines.



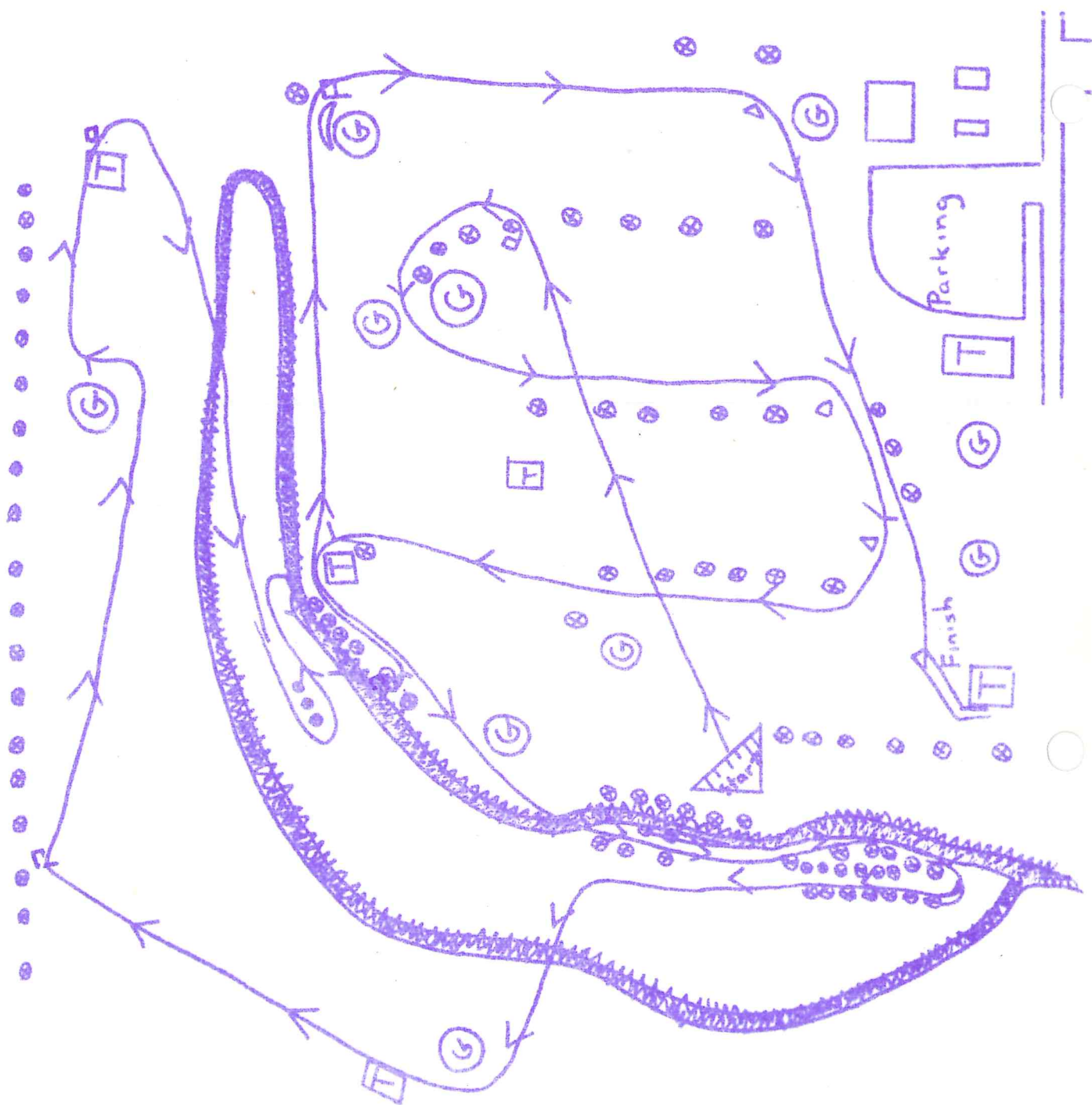
SPECIAL NOTICE TO COACHES

1. If you do not have a full team CALL the host school, H. F. Brockman, Athletic Director. Telephone: 853-3328
2. SUBSTITUTIONS may be made from the Eligibility Certificate only.
3. District to Sectional - The first, second, third, fourth, and fifth place teams and the first ten individual runners to finish in each District will advance to Sectional competition at the center to which they are assigned.
4. District Medals will be awarded to the first five place individuals and to the members of the first place team.
A plaque will be awarded to the first place team.

SCORING INFORMATION

In order to give a coach and his team quick scoring results so they may leave the field quickly as possible we will use the quick scoring system.

1. Each individual contestant MUST wear a small identification scoring card which must be clipped to the top of his running jersey. Card must be kept thus intact until removed by a judge. Each card should have the runner's name and school on it before the event begins. A place card number will be given to each runner at the finish, for the coaches' use in figuring his score. The official score will be taken from the I.D. tag worn on the top of the jersey. If a runner loses his I.D. a substitute will be inserted by the judges. The places will be placed on the score boards as they they are okayed by the judges.
2. Each contestant will be furnished a set of large numerals (identical numbers) which MUST be worn on BOTH the FRONT and the BACK of their jersey during the run.
