Two days later, though, the Leafs bounced back to place fourth out of 20 teams in the Class B division of the Ottawa Invitational. In that meet, senior Rob Amans, unbeaten in dual competition through Sept. 17, placed fifth, the best finish by a Geneseo runner since Randy Pobanz' running days.

On Sept. 17 at St. Bede, the Leafs lost to powerful Princeton (the Tigers also won at Ottawa) but beat the hosting Bruins.

Last Saturday, the Leafs were seventh out of 10 teams in the Geneseo Invitational, which was won by Princeton and featured a strong field, which included Rock Island and Alleman — two schools the Leafs defeated.

Sterling's Pat Fortney won that race, run on Geneseo's tough 2.8-mile Richmond Hill course. Amans placed seventh in 14:17 — which is about a minute faster than the Leaf senior had ever run it before.

AMANS: BETTER EVERY MEET

"We had a bad day, except for Amans," said Durian. "He hasn't had a bad day yet."

During track season this past spring, Amans brought his time down in the two-mile race in nearly every meet. His best was 10 minutes flat.

"Rob has a lot of natural ability," said Durian. "I can't say he's worked a great deal harder than some of the others on the squad, but he runs easily, with long, flowing strides."

CATOUR: WORK, WORK, AND MORE WORK

Amans ran about 300 miles on his own this summer — and every squad member ran about 200 miles between the time practice started and the first meet.

For sheer work, though, no one on the squad matched the 754 miles logged by senior Rob Catour. Added to the 200 during practice, Catour ran nearly 1,000 miles getting ready for this season. He lettered for the varsity as a sophomore and as a junior. "He's small but steady," said Durian. "He'll run anywhere from our second to our fifth man."

After Amans, five Leafs are about even, including Catour, senior Jeff Jewell (300 miles this summer), junior Doug Hursman (200), and sophomores Jeff Fitzgerald (350) and Mark Nordstrom (350). Nordstrom won a varsity letter last year, and grew 4 inches during the summer to his present height, 6-1, according to Durian.

Senior Bruce Abbott, junior Brian Smith, and sophomores Doug Longman and Greg Wisely vie for the seventh position on the Leaf varsity.

Longman, top runner on the sophomore squad, ran for the track team last spring, but didn't give any indication of coming out for cross country until school started, according to Durian, who added, "he's really been a surprise."

HARD WORK — AND SOME GOALS

The Leafs run four to eight miles every night after school, unless Durian elects to do some speed work, when emphasis is on quarter-miles and 220-yard dashes.

"We'd like to take the entire team to the sectional meet this year," said Durian. In order to do that, the Leafs must finish among the top five at district. Individuals can qualify for the sectional by placing among the top 10 at district.

Geneseo's schedule is as tough as it's ever been — and tough opponents can bring out the best in a runner.

Princeton, which placed 23rd in the state last season and figures to do even better this fall, appears on Geneseo's schedule at least a half-dozen times.

Tuesday, the Leafs participated in a triangular with East Moline and Rock Island.

Saturday at 11 a.m., the Leafs travel to Sauk Valley College for the Dixon Invitational. The lineup? DeKalb, Dixon, Freeport, Kewanee, Moline, Sterling, and Streator, among others. Obviously, Geneseo isn't backing away from anyone.

"To win," said Durian, "you try to get five runners to run well together, or if you have an outstanding runner, like Amans, you try to get four behind him to finish high."

Although it's a team sport, cross country is very much a sport for the individual as well. There isn't much glory involved — football certainly gets the lion's share of the public's attention. However, there probably is more comradeship among cross country runners, whether they're teammates or foes.

"There's much personal satisfaction involved," said Durian. "We have a good time. We try to win, and if we don't, we try harder next time."
