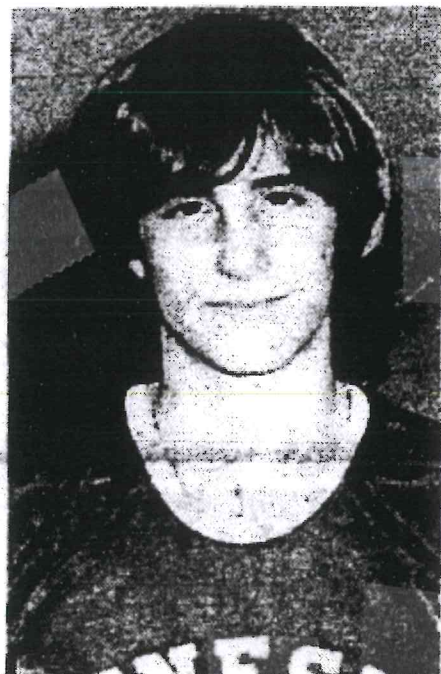


Rich Amans to race in state meet



Senior Rob Amans paced the Geneseo Cross Country Team to a respectable 11th place in the state sectional meet. The Leaf runners out placed Rock Island and East Moline for the first time this year to end the season on a good note. Senior Rob Catour had one of his best meets of the season finishing second for the Leaf runners.

The competitive season is over for all but Rob Amans who placed 8th individually to qualify for the state meet.

"This was a 100% effort on the part of Amans," Coach Durian commented. "With $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile to go, Rob was in 13th place. When he finished he was in 8th place which means he passed 5 good runners in the last $\frac{3}{4}$ mile to get to state. Rob really wanted to go to state as his performance has shown."

Geneseo's Rob Amans finished eighth in the sectional cross country meet Saturday at Detwiler Park in Peoria, and because he was one of the top 10 finishers, he'll return to Detwiler this Saturday for the state meet.

Geneseo finished 11th in the 15-team meet, and beat East Moline and Rock Island. The top three schools from five districts competed, and Peoria Central won the meet.

Coach Steve Durian said he was very pleased with his team's performance. About 120 runners participated in the meet, which covered a three-mile distance.

Amans was running in 13th place with three quarters of a mile to go, but Durian said he then turned on the speed and passed seven runners, to take over the sixth spot.

He lost two at the finish, but had his trip to state clinched.

Central, Bandy Take Firsts

It's called the "triangle."
The section of the cross-country course at Detweiller Park out of sight of most spectators... across the bridge, behind the bushes.

IT'S WHERE more than one cross-country meet has been decided.

And where another one was Saturday as Illinois Valley Central's Bill Bandy ran to first individually and Central triumphed collectively in the sectional meet.

The Lions converted their four-man pack strategy into 66 points to 85 for runnerup Richwoods. Bandy led IVC to third — worth a team spot in the state field of 26.

Six individuals also advanced without their teams, including Brad Fryer of Elmwood, John Isbell of Farmington and John Roberts of Spalding.

At Sterling, Princeton and Henry's Harold Winship earned spots in the state finals at Detweiller next Saturday. Princeton placed third as a team, while Winship ran fourth individually.

Bandy, who pulled past Isbell into first at the mile mark, was "very conscious" of running a fast second mile.

He entered the triangle early in the second mile, with a short lead and emerged with a long one.

HE WAS very disappointed after the district," said IVC coach Wendy Childs. There Richwoods' Steve Patterson had little trouble beating Bandy.

Saturday Bandy won by 14 seconds in 14:47 with Patterson fourth in 15:05.

While Central's final winning margin was convincing, halfway through the race it was in doubt.

"Gary (Brewer) started to hurt going into the far

turn (of the triangle)," said Central coach Bob LaCroix, "so John (Fetcho) laid back to help him. Gary's the type of runner who'll do well if somebody is there beside him."

Meanwhile sophomores Dave Ayoub and Rick Parker were running toward a six-nine actual finish that was worth four-seven in the team standings.

"If I had lost them in the triangle I don't know where I would have finished," said Ayoub, who clipped 22 seconds off his previous personal best by running 15:09. "Rick and I really helped each other out."

Fetcho had blamed himself for Central's poor showing in the district (tied for second).

In that race, he broke away from the Lions' pack and while Parker and he finished fourth, Ayoub and Brewer faded badly.

"I FIGURED that if Gary fell too far back we'd be in real trouble," said Fetcho, who acknowledged his best personal strategy would call for a fast first two miles.

"He (Fetcho) ran 20 seconds slower than his best time," noted LaCroix. "But I could care less. He and Brian Scheuble were the key for us."

Fifth man Scheuble continued to close the gap between himself and the Central pack as he finished 27th when the unattached runners were deleted for scoring purposes.

"SHUBE REALLY turned one on for us today," said Fetcho. "He was really wanting the medals (each member of the team got one)."

The sectional trophy — Central's third in a row — was the first trophy the Lions had won all year.

Richwoods' disappointment was compounded when the Knights learned Chris Rider won't be able to compete in the

state meet.

"The muscles apparently pulled the pelvis apart," said Richwoods' coach Ty Franklin, noting it was a very un-medical explanation.

"He was referred to a specialist Monday. I think rest is the only thing, but I'm no specialist."

Rider injured himself with about 600 yards to go in the race and struggled in 36th (with the individuals taken out).
