The race will be run over a course of 2.97 miles on the Baker Park Golf Course in Baker Park, located just northwest of the city on U.S. #81. Spikes may be worn on the course, which is principally on grass and is gently rolling in contour.

The meet will be run under the rules published in the National Edition of the Track and Field Guide as follows in the District and State meets. Each school may enter ten boys. Seven will be permitted to run in the meet and the first five finishers from each school will count towards the team score.

Please send entry fee of \$10.00 and eligibility lists to Ken Vincent, Cross Country Coach, Kewanee High School.

The meet will start promptly at 4:30 p.m. Please have your runners warmed up and ready to go. At 4:00 p.m. a trip will be made over the course for all who desire it.

The finish will be in a chute. As the runners come into the finish chute, each will be given a card with the number of his place in the field. The Coaches will collect these cards.

Medals will be awarded to the first 5 finishers and ribbons to the next 15. A trophy will be given for the 1st and 2nd place teams.

We welcome your participation in this meet and appreciate any suggestions that you might have for its improvement. Next years meet will be held on October 12, 1976. Please hold this date open on your schedule.
