

Geneseo to host invitational cross country run Saturday

After putting in a dandy week of running, Geneseo's varsity cross country team this Saturday will host the Geneseo Invitational at Richmond Hill Park.

The frosh-soph meet will start at 10:30 a.m., with the three-mile varsity race getting under way after the sophomore event is completed.

The teams entered should have runners who will turn in dandy times. Participating schools include Rock Falls, East Moline, Princeton, Rock Island, Sterling, Kewanee, LaSalle-Peru, Alleman, Chillicothe, Streator, and Geneseo.

The past week saw the Maple Leafs score their first win over Princeton in the five years Steve Durian has been Geneseo's head cross country coach. The win, by a 27-30 margin, came Tuesday night of this week at Princeton.

Mark Nordstrom, running strong for the Leafs, placed second behind Princeton's outstanding runner, Steve Arch. But Nordstrom led a Geneseo parade. Doug Longman was third, Dan Fitzgerald was fourth, Jeff Fitzgerald was sixth, then Kirk Hodgson was 12th. Ron Brummett placed 14th.

The win gave the varsity a dual meet record of 2-3.

The frosh-soph team upped its record to 5-0 with another tight, 26-29 win over the Kittens, the second Geneseo win over Princeton this season. Keith Kincaid placed second, Bob Fitzgerald was third, Jim Nordstrom was sixth, Bob Johnson seventh, Jay Abbott eighth, and Jay Poulos was 12th.

The Maple Leafs earlier had a fine effort in the Class B division of the Ottawa Invitational, run

Saturday, Sept. 18 on Ottawa's flat, humid course along the Illinois and Fox rivers. Geneseo placed third out of 18 teams.

Coach Durian called it the team's best effort of the season to date. "This was an especially pleasing finish because we took the hardware away from Princeton and Prophetstown, who finished fourth and fifth, respectively."

Individual places included Mark Nordstrom sixth, Dan Fitzgerald 11th, Doug Longman 13th, Jeff Fitzgerald 34th, Kirk Hodgson 56th, Ron Brummett 78th, and Greg Meyers 99th. There were 118 runners.

The Leaflets placed eighth at Ottawa with freshmen Keith

Kincaid and Bob Fitzgerald placing eighth and 10th, respectively.

Last Thursday, the Leafs had a disappointing meet when they dropped a 21-37 dual to Kewanee at Baker Park Golf Course in Kewanee. Dan Fitzgerald took top individual honors, though, and has been named Leaf runner of the week.

The Leaflets upped their mark to 4-0 at Kewanee by posting a perfect low score, 15, compared with 45 by Kewanee. Geneseo swept the first five places, including Keith Kincaid, first, Bob Fitzgerald second, Jay Abbott, third, Jim Nordstrom, fourth, and Robert Johnson, fifth.

Ottawa High welcomes you to its Eleventh Annual Cross Country Invitational to be held at Ottawa High School on Saturday, September 18, 1976, at 10:00 AM.

We plan four (4) different divisions again this year according to the following time schedule:

10:00 AM - Class B Fresh-Soph Run	(A team run for school with enrollments of less than 1200 students; 5 to 7 must run)
10:20 AM - Class A Fresh-Soph Run	(A team run for schools with enrollments of 1200 or more students; 5 to 7 must run)
10:40 AM - Class B Varsity Run	(Same qualifications as F-S run)
11:00 AM - Class A Varsity Run	(Same qualifications as F-S run)

In place of the customary entry sheets, we ask you to fill out the enclosed questionnaire and return it with your eligibility sheet & entry fee no later than Monday, September 13. Please remember that each division above is a team run; therefore, 5 to 7 boys must run. A boy may not run in more than one division.

AWARDS

Trophies will be awarded to the first, second, and third place teams in the Class B & Class A Varsity runs, and to the first and second place teams in the Class A & Class B Fresh-Soph runs.

Individual trophies will be awarded to the first 10 runners and ribbons to the next 20 runners to finish in the Class A & Class B varsity.

Ribbons will be awarded to the first 30 runners to finish in the Fresh-Soph. runs.

The award ceremony will immediately follow the conclusion of the Class A Varsity run.

The following three (3) items must be returned by Monday, September 13. Send to Bob Anderson, Ottawa High.

- 1) The enclosed questionnaire
- 2) The official IHSA eligibility sheet
- 3) Entry fee of \$20 (Make check payable to Ottawa High School)

COURSE

The course is basically grass with approximately one quarter of a mile on the cinder track. Of course, all runners must wear shoes or spikes. Varsity course length is 2.95 miles & F-S length is 2.27.

TOURS OF THE COURSE

Tours will be held at 8:45 and 9:15 AM.

DRESSING FACILITIES

Teams must dress at home since we have little locker space available. Each school is responsible for its own valuables.

STARTING LINE

The chute or box system of starting will be used with team boxes predetermined by a drawing held during the week. Because of the class divisions, we must draw these starting positions in advance.

FINISH

A chute will be used in compliance with Cross Country Running Rules, the only exception being that the finish line will be the narrow of the chute instead of the mouth.

SCORING SYSTEM

Upon arrival, each coach should report to the Meet Manager at the Scorer's Table. The coach will be given an envelope containing last minute instructions and tags. Each tag must be filled in by the coach in advance of the run. Clip the tag to the front of the runner's shirt. When he finishes the run, he will present his tag to the Scorer in the finish chute, who in turn will tell the runner his individual place. Your cooperation with these instructions will help us to speed-score the team results.

IN CASE OF DELUGE OR RAIN

Because of the proximity of the Illinois and Fox rivers, King Field occasionally floods in the fall. Since we have no alternate date for the Invitational, every effort will be made to hold the Invitational according to schedule. In case of flood, however, please submit on the enclosed questionnaire where you can be reached by phone between 6:30 and 8 AM Saturday morning, September 18.

BUSSES AND SPECTATORS

Because of the huge entry field and number of runners, would you please ask your squad to cooperate on the following matters:

- (1) Please park busses in the middle of the King Field parking lot. Runners will be competing along the grass edges of the parking lot.

- 2) All spectators and runners who are not participating at the time of a run should sit in the south bleachers of the football field, the best vantage point to see the entire meet.
- 3) Please instruct your runners to stay off the football field.
