"WORST RACE"

"As a team, we ran our worst race of the year," said Geneseo cross country coach Jeff Quick, after his squad placed third in a nine-school field Saturday at the Princeton Invitational.

Princeton won the team title, followed by Sterling Newman. Bryan Colbert again was Geneseo's top place finisher, taking a third behind winner Craig Martin of Princeton, and second place Shipp of Prophetstown.

"None of our seven runners were satisfied with their performance," said Quick. "It was especially tough to lose to Sterling Newman for the second time in one week. Plus, we missed a team trophy by just eight points, which is close in a nine-team meet."

Quick was happier with his frosh-soph team, which also copped third place, but showed general improvement. Ron-Clifton was top Geneseo place finisher at 6th overall.

There was a girls' race, but no team points were kept. Had there been a team award, Geneseo would have been 30 points in front of the field.

"The girls continue to amaze me, as they really go out after the opposition," said Quick. "For a group of kids conditioning themselves for other sports, they are doing a great job." Only two of Geneseo's 15 girl harriers are seniors, which points toward possible success next season when the first girls' state meet is run.

GIRLS ARE NOVELTY

Girls cross country is still a bit of a novelty... to some boys.

The Leaf girls were steaming to their second victory in history Tuesday afternoon, beating Princeton in a dual meet at Richmond Hill Park.

Some frosh-soph boys were near the finish line. Cheering? Well, not exactly. Someone threw a dead frog into the finish chute.

"Get that out of there!" hollered Leaf Coach Jeff Quick, who forced himself not to smile.

The Leaf girls weren't bothered by the frog, though, and 94-degree heat didn't seem to hamper them either, as they beat Princeton 23-35.

The race for first was between Geneseo's Mary Herold and Princeton's Missy Scott. They had hooked up for the first time Saturday in the Princeton Invitational, Scott winning by 15 seconds. She's a veteran runner, and sometimes competes for the Princeton boys' team.

This time, Herold took out after her off the starting line. The two were in front of the pack early, and Herold was in front of Scott to stay after a mile.

Herold covered the two-mile distance in 13:59, with Scott second at 14:36. Geneseo's Nancy Swain was third at 15:18.

"The girls continue to improve," said Quick, who pointed out that Geneseo was without its usual number two runner, Lisa Selboe. The Leaf girls are one of 13 teams entered in Saturday's Geneseo Invitational.
