LEAFS RUN STRONG IN NIB-12 CONFERENCE X-C MEET

On Saturday, October 19th, the Leafs traveled to Morris to participate in the Northern Illinois Big 12 Conference Cross Country Meet. The meet was held on Morris High School's grounds. The Leafs enjoyed a team-bonding 2-hour bus ride and were greeted with a daytime high of 50° and 10-15 mph winds. All in all, not a bad day for late October.

As we knew going into the meet, the competition would be intense. There is little argument to the fact that the NIB-12 is the toughest XC Conference in the state of Illinois. We made the most of our opportunities and ran strong at all levels.

The Varsity Girls got things going with the crack of the starter's gun at 10:00 AM sharp. The two-time defending state champion Yorkville Foxes won the championship with a powerful Kaneland team only 14 points behind. We placed a very respectable 5th and were only 20 points out of 3rd place. Senior Halle Olson led the way with a strong 14th place showing. Not far behind was Junior Katie Puls who just missed All-Confenece honors (Top 21) with her 23rd place finish. Next up were Sophomore Taylor Claus and Freshman Megan Coulter who battled each

other all the way to the finish chute and claimed 28th and 29th places respectfully. Closing our scoring was Sophomore Molly Lembke who ran a strong race herself and finished in 31st place. Next up were Senor Captains Jessa Coulter and Morgan Kelly who placed 36th and 43rd respectfully. Way to race, Ladies. Continue the momentum next Saturday in East Peoria.

Next up were the Varsity Boys who took off at 10:45 AM. Once again the field was loaded with multiple state-ranked teams toeing the line. Freshman Nathan Soria, once again, led the Leafs with a very impressive 17th place finish which earned him All-Conference Honors. The Leafs then threw a wonderful pack with Senior Tony Gatter, Junior David Chenoweth, Senior Chaise Blakley, and Senior Mitchell Lamb going 27th, 29th, 30th, and 32nd places respectfully. Not far behind were sophomore phenoms Gabe Johnson and Charley Elden who sprinted home in 40th and 41st places. This was an AWESOME team effort and we are just getting started with Championship Meet Season. Next Saturday we qualify for Sectionals and then follow that up with "Show Time" on November 2nd at Maxwell Park in Normal.

The F/S Girls were up next and put up a ferocious fight. Yorkville, the two time defending State Champions (currently ranked number one this year also) threw 6 in the top 7 to win the race going away. The Leafs fought off several other powerful squads to claim the silver medal and were led by Sophomore Madison Miller (8th), Sophomore Becca Rapps (11th), Sophomore Lauren Coulter (12th), Freshman Sally DeBrock (13th), Freshman Katelyn Mielke (14th), and Freshman Emma Alexander (19th) who all earned All-Conference Honors via their top 21 finishes. Freshman Morgan Hartsock ran into a nasty side ache and was unable to finish the race. Ladies, your races were inspiring and to say our future looks bright is a tremendous understatement.

The F/S boys took off at High Noon and roared to a strong 3rd place finish themselves and were led by Freshman Charlie Schlindwein's sparkling 13th place which earned him All-Conference Honors. Next up were: Freshman Luke Johnson, Sophomore Keaton Darin, and Freshman Kyle Sellers who packed it in via their tight 26th, 27th, and 28th place finishes. Closing the scoring was rookie Freshman Chandler Schwartz in 40th place with fellow Freshman Keith Elden and Tate Neff not far behind in 44th and 49th place finishes respectfully. Following the Coaches meeting at 9:15 AM it was decided to run the open races together to shorten the meet by 45 minutes. I applaud this move because this is already an extremely long meet.
