Class 2A Peoria Notre Dame

Where: Illinois Central College, East Peoria. When: 10:30 a.m. (boys), 11:15 a.m. (girls).

Who advances: The top six teams and top five individuals not on a qualifying team advance to the Normal West Sectional at Maxwell Park next weekend.

Teams: Alleman, Geneseo, Rock Island, Galesburg, Bartonville Limestone, Dunlap, Peoria High, Peoria Notre Dame, Peoria Richwoods.

Storylines: On the boys' side, the Alleman Pioneers cruised to a 1A regional title last season, but right out of the gate Alleman will be tested at the 2A level by Dunlap. The Pioneers' Zach Hird looks to add an individual regional crown to his resume. Alleman's Kienan Otto and Matthew Mallary are never far behind Hird to make a formidable pack. Geneseo's Nathan Soria should be another runner in the mix after a strong performance (17th, 15:53) in the NIB 12 Meet. Rock Island's Cole Neder has run well in big meets, leading Rock Island at the Western Big 6 Meet (16:58), and at the 2A First to the Finish Invitational (16:36).

On the girls' side, the Pioneers' trek into the 2A championship season begins with a tough challenge. Defending regional champion Peoria Notre Dame is the front-runner for the team title. After a strong race at Western Big 6, Alleman's Kaytlyn Golding and Kevan O'Hanlon should challenge to be at the head of the pack. Geneseo's another team that shouldn't be overlooked finishing second at sectionals last season. The Maple Leafs run well as a pack and are paced by Halle Olson who finished 14th (18:57) at NIB 12 Conference run last weekend among some elite talent. Rock Island's Sarah Stockdale looks to keep her momentum going after leading the Rocky pack with a 20th place finish last week.

Geneseo's boys' and girls' cross country teams took the next step toward a state trip as both squads advanced out of the Peoria Notre Dame Regional Oct. 26.

"The No. 1 goal was to advance, and the kids did a great job of taking care of that assignment," said head coach Don Fredericks. "Now we have the chance to line up in a very competitive sectional and it is going to be a real challenge to get through."

The Lady Leafs finished fourth overall to move on and were led by Katie Puls in sev-

enth place with a time of 19 minutes and 28.9 seconds.

Morgan Kelly placed 19th in 20:19.2; followed by Halle Olson in 21st place at 20:28.4 and Megan Coulter in 24th place at 20:36.0.

Taylor Claus took 28th overall in 20:44.7; while Molly Lembke finished 33rd in 21:05.5, and Jessa Coulter, 34th at 21:07.2.

The Leafs took home a fifth-place team finish to advance and were led by Chaise Blakley in 14th place with a time of 16:34.8.

Nathan Soria came in 18th in 16:46.4; while Tony Gatter took 26th at 16:58.0, and Charley Elden, 27th in 17:00.7.

Mitchell Lamb took 28th in

17:03.1; followed by David Chenoweth in 34th at 17:13.1, and Gabe Johnson, 39th in 17:26.5.

"Katie Puls had a monster race and so did Morgan Kelly, who ran a phenomenal race," said Fredericks. "Nathan Soria hit a bad patch, and Chaise Blakley stepped up and ran a phenomenal race."

Geneseo's runners will be in action at the Normal Community West Sectional at 11:15 a.m. Nov. 2.

"I want to see the best race of the season," said Fredericks. "Our peak has been designed for this Saturday so all systems should be a go. I want them to have no excuses, no retreats and no regrets."
