The meet is included in the Augustana College's Brissman-Lundeen Invitational and included over 30 teams from across the Midwest. Several nationally ranked teams were in the field for both the women's race and the men's. Augustana was able to squeeze three extra races into their schedule (a Middle School – girls and boys together and girls and boys high school races. The high school races had both Varsity and F/S levels of competition and utilized a chip timing system. The team was also racing without Coach "T" due to the awesome arrival of her new granddaughter. Everything is fine and she has never been spotted with a bigger smile.

The meet is one of my favorite of the entire season. First off, it's run on a golf course so the footing is as good as it gets. Secondly, I love the atmosphere. Only 6 points separated the top 3 teams and when the dust had settled, the Lady Leafs had won the coolest trophy of the regular season (a HUGE runner on a platform.) Halle Olson led the way with a gutsy, front running style race, that netted her 2nd place overall. Katie Puls wasn't far behind in 7th place and gives the Lady Leafs a powerful top 2. Not to be outdone, Megan Coulter, Morgan Kelly, and Molly Lembke sprinted into the finish chute in 9th, 12th, and 13th places respectfully to close the scoring and take an impressive team victory. Not far behind was Taylor Claus (19th) who joined in the top 20 medal party. ROCK ISLAND — On a breezy afternoon, it was only fitting that the two first place individuals at the Rock Island Cross Country Invitational breezed to comfortable victories.

On the boys side, Alleman's Zach Hird blazed to a first-place 15:09 finish to help the Pioneers take the team title with a score of 22 points. His time was a minute faster than second-place teammate Wesley Graham.

Hird led from start to finish, which allowed the senior to pace himself without overexerting.

"When I went around the final turn, I already knew I was well ahead," he said. He expressed that while he did not need an "all-out" finish, he didn't ease up in the race.


It wasn't all too easy for Hird, as he noted the breeze played a role.

"With a golf course comes wind a lot of the time, because there are no trees," he said. He added that based on the direction of the wind, a few stretches took more out of him than normal, but it was to be expected as wind is always a factor.

Hird's domination didn't remove all the drama from the boys race, however. Graham and United Township's Sean Dopler had a tense battle for second place. Graham beat him16:11.1 to 16.11.2. Despite missing a runner-up finish by the narrowest of margins, Dopler led the way for the Panthers in the absence of fellow senior Austin Webster.

"I knew it was my time to shine," said Dopler. "I knew I had to step up for the team."

UT coach Chris Wallaert praised Dopler's finish and expressed pride in his performance.

"Sean has really taken a nice step up," Wallaert said. "He works hard, he's very focused and I'm very proud of his efforts today."


As a team, Alleman placed six of its seven runners in the top 10. That performance allowed the Pioneers to place first over Geneseo (63) by 41 points. UT (79), Rock Island (92) and Moline (139) rounded out the top five teams.

For the girls, Moline senior Brisa Almanza took first place with an 18:59 finish, putting her 30 seconds ahead of Geneseo senior Halle Olson, who came in second at 19:29. Olson's squad took first with 43 points.

Having the lead the entire time didn't mean it was not a challenge for Almanza, as she shared Hird's statements on the difficulties of being so far ahead.

"It's hard being in the lead because you don't have anyone to chase after," she said, "and no one right behind you to motivate you."

Almanza said that as a team, the Maroons have the goal of repeating as Western Big 6 Conference champions, a sentiment echoed by her coach, Tauwon Taylor. Even though his team was



not at full strength, Taylor was able to get a feel for how the girls stood up to some of the competition they will face down the road. Moline finished third despite only running five girls. He also got a chance to see Almanza lead the way for the first time.

"Brisa did an excellent job

today, from start to finish," he said. "Hopefully we can continue that and stay healthy.

Moline, Geneseo and Alleman each placed three finishers among the top nine individual finishers. Alleman (47) edged out Moline (49) for runner-up. Rock Island was fourth with 114.
