LEAFS RUN WILD AT ROCK ISLAND INVITATIONAL

On Friday, September 27th, the Leafs traveled to Rock Island's Saukie Golf Course to participate in the Rock Island Invitational. The meet is included in the Augustana College's Brissman-Lundeen Invitational and included over 30 teams from across the Midwest. Several nationally ranked teams were in the field for both the women's race and the men's. Augustana was able to squeeze three extra races into their schedule (a Middle School - girls and boys together and girls and boys high school races. The high school races had both Varsity and F/S levels of competition and utilized a chip timing system. The team was also racing without Coach "T" due to the awesome arrival of her new granddaughter. Everything is fine and she has never been spotted with a bigger smile.

The meet is one of my favorite of the entire season. First off, it's run on a golf course so the footing is as good as it gets. Secondly, I love the atmosphere. meet in Minnesota), Rock Island, and United Township. The field isn't huge but is certainly elite. The Varsity Girls race came down to a "Dog Fight" between Geneseo, Alleman, and Moline. Only 6 points separated the top 3 teams and when the dust had settled, the Lady Leafs had won the coolest trophy of the regular season (a HUGE runner on a platform.) Halle Olson led the way with a gutsy, front running style race, that netted her 2nd place overall. Katie Puls wasn't far behind in 7th place and gives the Lady Leafs a powerful top 2. Not to be outdone, Megan Coulter, Morgan Kelly, and Molly Lembke sprinted into the finish chute in 9th, 12th, and 13th places respectfully to close the scoring and take an impressive team victory. Not far behind was Taylor Claus (19th) who joined in the top 20 medal party. Next up were : essa Coulter (24th), Sarah Dellett (36th), Mikayla Bowton (40th), Cortney Backes (43rd), Ashley Kempher (44th), Abby Larson (51st), and Savannah Chapman in 57th place. Great efforts, Ladies. Keep up the great work and get ready to FLY come Championship Meet Season.

The F/S girls race was contesting with the Varsity Girls race so it was impossible to know which athletes where in which race. I LOVE IT. Each man earned an coveted top 20 medal as they shocked several teams by claiming 2nd place as a team. Next up were: Chris Bagley (39th), Sean Geffert (41st), Karl Flynn (42nd), Payton DeMay (46th), Josiah Cropp (49th), Bryce Gramling (55th), Raul Falcon (61st), James Hartsock (66th), and Tyler Mahsem in 73rd place. Girls grab gold, boys take silver at Rock Island Invite

Geneseo's female runners led the charge for the Geneseo cross country team at the Sept. 27 Rock Island Invite as the Lady Leafs grabbed top honors in both the varsity and freshman/sophomore races.

"The field is not huge, but there are some really good teams there," said head coach Don Fredericks. "For the girls, it was a huge win. It was close and a three-horse race with Alleman and Moline."

Halle Olson paced the varsity girls with a second-place finish in 19 minutes and 29.6 seconds; followed by Katie Puls, seventh, 20:17.6; and Megan Coulter, ninth, 20:47.0.

Morgan Kelly took home 12th in 20:55.5; while Molly Lembke finished 13th, 20:56.5; Taylor Claus, 19th, 21:37.0; and Jessa Coulter, 24th, 21:56.0.

"Halle was in second the entire race, and Katie was pretty much in the same spot, but our pack did a great job moving up and it was enough to win the meet," said Fredericks.

Sarah Dellett came in 36th, 22:42.6; followed by Mikayla Bowton, 40th, 22:53.8; Cortney Backes, 43rd, 22:58.1; Ashley Kempher, 44th, 23:06.5; Abby Larson, 51st, 23:46.8; and

Savannah Chapman, 57th, 24:22.0.

The freshman/sophomore girls swept the Top 4 spots in their race — Madison Miller, first, 21:50.9; Emma Alexander, second, 21:58.6; Becca Rapps, third, 22:06.6; and Sally DeBrock, fourth, 22:08.0.

Callie Miller took 17th in 24:08.1; followed by Katelyn Mielke, 18th, 24:11.5; and Alexis Perren, 43rd, 30:19.4.

"Sweeping the 1-4 spots is a great sign for the future, and it really shows the depth on our team," said Fredericks.

Both boys' squads earned runner-up honors at the invite.

Freshman Nathan Soria led the varsity boys with a seventh-place finish in 16:48.8; followed by Tony Gatter, 11th, 17:05.7; Chaise Blakley, 13th, 17:05.7; and Mitchell Lamb, 14th, 17:18.3.

"Nathan took a chance, he is a front runner and went out with the lead group, which is the fastest he has ever gone out," said Fredericks. "It was definitely the best race of his life. He ran a phenomenal race."

David Chenoweth finished in 18th place with a time of 17:29.0; while Chris Bagley, 40th, 19:14.0; Sean Geffert, 41st, 19:17.6; Karl Flynn, 42nd, 19:21.9; and Payton DeMay, 46th, 19:27.7.

Josiah Cropp took 49th in

19:43.6; followed by Bryce Gramling, 55th, 20:02.0; Raul Falcon, 61st, 20:54.8; James Hartsock, 66th, 21:58.5; and Tyler Mahsem, 73rd, 25:10.2.

"The pack behind Nathan did a great job," said Fredericks. "The key to success is to get some front runners, take a chance and go out a little harder. We did have people go out more aggressive and the packs moved up. We need to do that."

Charley Elden was the top finisher for the freshman/sophomore boys in third place with a time of 17:31.4; followed by Gabe Johnson, 11th, 18:30.9; Keaton Darin, 19th, 18:46.9; and Luke Johnson, 24th, 19:15.3.

Chandler Schwartz took 37th in 20:24.5; followed by Charlie Schlindwein, 40th, 20:36.7; Tate Neff, 45th, 20:57.6; Keegan Banister, 47th, 21:03.3; and Sam Murray, 49th, 21:05.3.

Nathan Konvicka finished in 53rd at 21:22.1; followed by Keith Elden, 55th, 21:38.7; Matt Ganson, 54th, 22:20.8; Ross Chapman, 72nd, 23:48.1; Bryan Dellett, 73rd, 24:28; Nelson Laingen, 74th, 24:58.2; and Ethan Baumgardner, 80th, 33:16.1.

"We had a lot of real nice surprises and that is what you want," said Fredericks. "The goal is to keep getting faster."

Geneseo will be in action next at 9 a.m. Oct. 12 at the Sterling Invite.

Hird, Almanza grab gold at RI

ROCK ISLAND — On a breezy afternoon, it was only fitting that the two first place individuals at the Rock Island Cross Country Invitational breezed to comfortable victories.

On the boys side, Alleman's Zach Hird blazed to a first-place 15:09 finish to help the Pioneers take the team title with a score of 22 points. His time was a minute faster than second-place teammate Wesley Graham.

Hird led from start to finish, which allowed the senior to pace himself without overexerting.

"When I went around the final turn, I already knew I was well ahead," he said. He expressed that while he did not need an "all-out" finish, he didn't ease up in the race.

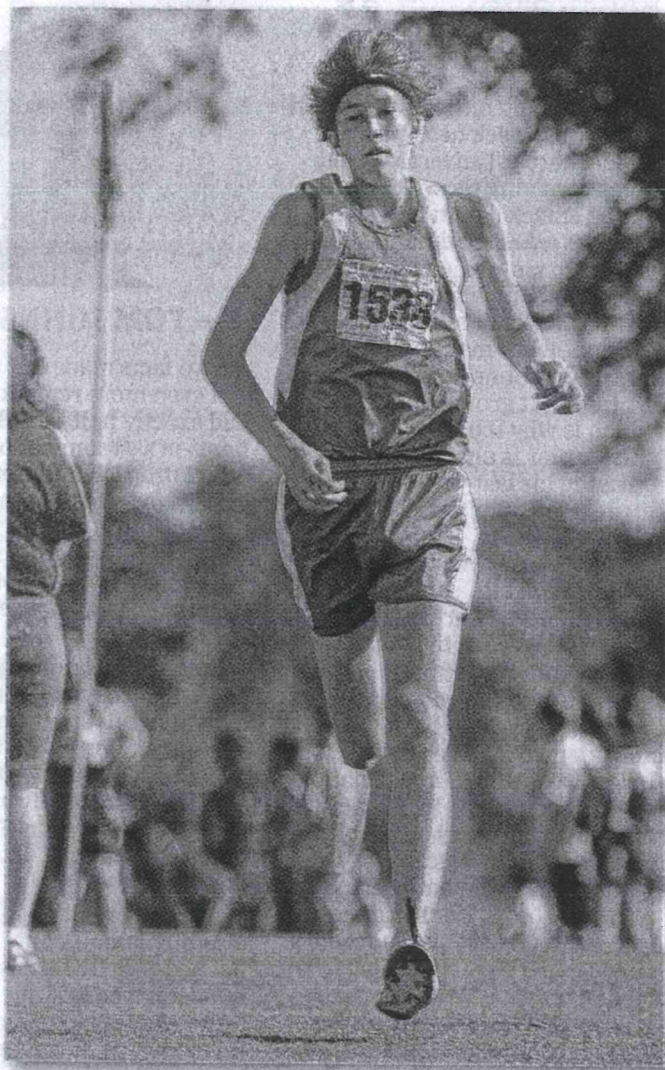
It wasn't all too easy for Hird, as he noted the breeze played a role.

"With a golf course comes wind a lot of the time, because there are no trees," he said. He added that based on the direction of the wind, a few stretches took more out of him than normal, but it was to be expected as wind is always a factor.

Hird's domination didn't remove all the drama from the boys race, however. Graham and United Township's Sean Dopler had a tense battle for second place. Graham beat him 16:11.1 to 16:11.2. Despite missing a runner-up finish by the narrowest of margins, Dopler led the way for the Panthers in the absence of fellow senior Austin Webster.

"I knew it was my time to shine," said Dopler. "I knew I had to step up for the team."

UT coach Chris Wallaert praised Dopler's finish and expressed pride in his performance.

"Sean has really taken a nice step up," Wallaert said. "He works hard, he's very focused and I'm very proud of his efforts today."

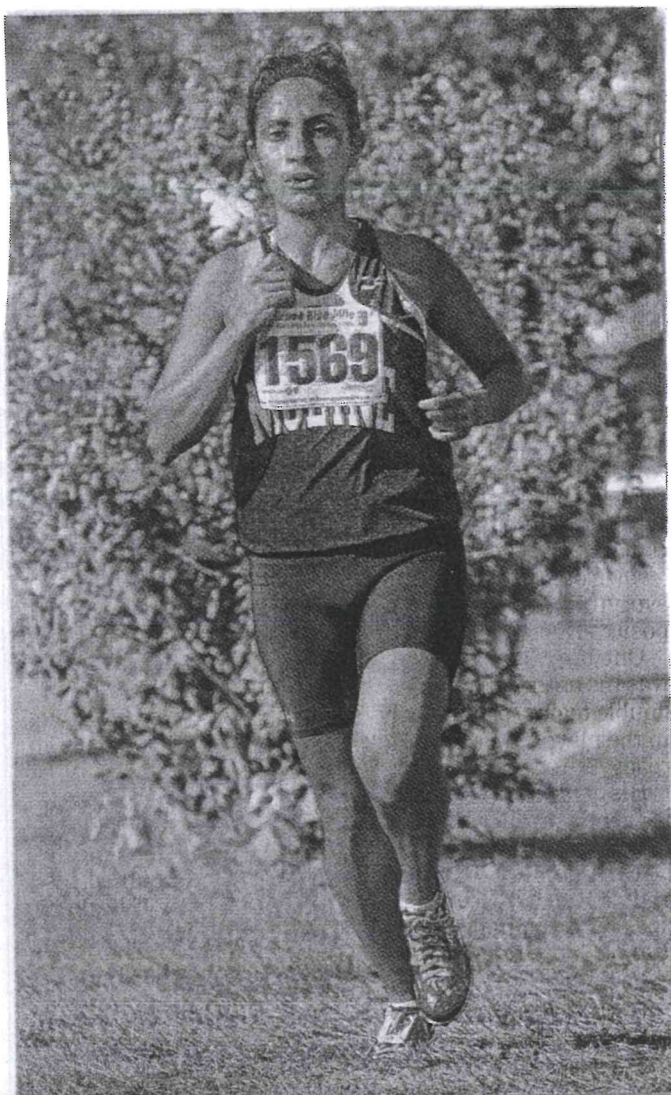
As a team, Alleman placed six of its seven runners in the top 10. That performance allowed the Pioneers to place first over Geneseo (63) by 41 points. UT (79), Rock Island (92) and Moline (139) rounded out the top five teams.

For the girls, Moline senior Brisa Almanza took first place with an 18:59 finish, putting her 30 seconds ahead of Geneseo senior Halle Olson, who came in second at 19:29. Olson's squad took first with 43 points.

Having the lead the entire time didn't mean it was not a challenge for Almanza, as she shared Hird's statements on the difficulties of being so far ahead.

"It's hard being in the lead because you don't have anyone to chase after," she said, "and no one right behind you to motivate you."

Almanza said that as a team, the Maroons have the goal of repeating as Western Big 6 Conference champions, a sentiment echoed by her coach, Tauwon Taylor. Even though his team was



not at full strength, Taylor was able to get a feel for how the girls stood up to some of the competition they will face down the road. Moline finished third despite only running five girls. He also got a chance to see Almanza lead the way for the first time.

"Brisa did an excellent job

today, from start to finish," he said. "Hopefully we can continue that and stay healthy."

Moline, Geneseo and Alleman each placed three finishers among the top nine individual finishers. Alleman (47) edged out Moline (49) for runner-up. Rock Island was fourth with 114.
