LEAFS PLACE 5TH IN ALL 3 LEVELS AT NIB-12 CONFERENCE CROSS COUNTRY MEET

On Saturday, October 18th, the Leafs traveled to Rochelle High School for the NIB-12 Conference Cross Country Meet. The meet was originally scheduled to be run at Skare Park in Rochelle but due to the heavy rains (over 3 inches) earlier in the week the meet was moved to Rochelle High School's campus. The team size dropped from the traditional 12 teams to 10 teams with the departure of Dixon and Streator to other conferences. Fear not, the competition was still intense and of the highest quality. The weatherman gave us a mixed bag with a daytime high of 46° and light rain off and on. Toss in 15 to 20 mph winds and you have a significantly challenging weather picture. The mud was flyin' and it was a fun day to mix it up with some of the state's very best.

The Varsity Boys got things rolling at 10:45 a.m. and were racing without Senior Co-Captain David Chenoweth (out with severe ankle tendonitis) and Sophomore Luke Johnson (illness.) They toed the line with only six men. The team put forth a strong effort and ended up in 5th place overall. Leading the way was Sophomore Nathan Soria who earned All-Conference Honors via his 17th place finish (Top 18 earned All-Conference.) Not far behind was Junior Charley Elden (20th) who "kissed the ground" early, got back up, and barely missed earning All-Conference Honors. Sophomore Charlie Schlindwein (23rd), Junior Gabe Johnson (46th), and Sophomore Kyle Sellers

(48th) closed the team scoring. Sophomore Keith Elden raced home in 59th to end the Varsity's day. Maple Leafs earn fifth at NIB 12

The Maple Leafs' had three runners finish in the Top 25 in an elite conference race.

Geneseo (154) finished fifth in the team standings behind champion Yorkville (23) who claimed the top three individual spots.

Running with only a six-man varsity team, the Maple Leafs still put together a solid performance.

Nathan Soria led the way finished 17th in 16:22 for Geneseo and earning all-conference honors.

Charley Elden continues to get stronger as the season progresses finishing 20th (16:28) just a few spots removed from all-conference.

Charlie Schlindwein gave Geneseo a three-man team at the top finishing in 23rd at 16:49.

Geneseo's Gabe Johnson was the next man to clock in at 46th place (17:36), Kyle Sellers came in 48th place (17:37) and Keith Elden fin-

ished 59th (18:11) to concluded the Maple Leafs varsity scoters.

The Maple Leafs freshman and sophomore team finished fifth (122) in the six team field.

Geneseo's Matthew Richtman won the individual title for Kaneland (16:36) and Yorkville won the team title (25).

Cameron Darin had a strong showing finishing in 15th place (18:15) to pace the Maple Leafs.

Geneseo's McGuire Hoon finished 28th (19:10), and Chandler Schwartz was just a few steps back in 29th (19:12).

The Leafs' Thackery Newton landed 32nd (19:33), and Christian Booth was 39th (20:38).

Sam Murray finished 41st (20:43) for Geneseo, and Nelson Laingen was 43rd (21:02).

"We are not on anyone's radar right now," Geneseo coach Don Fredericks said. "We were on nobody's radar last year either, but our guys
