UT's Riege motivated by state cross country finish

PEORIA — Kyle Riege approached the finish line in the Class 3A cross country state meet on Saturday afternoon with one thought in mind.

"The time," Riege said.

Turns out, it was his best ever:

The United Township junior runner clocked a personal-best time of 15:18 during a 79th-place finish at Detweiller Park, an ending that was both significant and motivational. Riege ended his campaign with a flourish, but is moving forward with higher goals and expectations.

"I put a lot of work into this season," Riege said. "I'm proud of everything I accomplished. I hope I have more to look forward to."

There is reason to believe that.

Riege, who three weeks ago finished as the Western Big 6 Conference runner-up, came on strong as the season neared its conclusion. How this stretch ended — Riege was the lone Big 6 state qualifier — makes him determined.

The personal-best finish in a fast field leaves him wanting more. Riege celebrated his ending before focusing on what he believes could be a special senior season.

"I'm hoping to get after it," Riege said.

Through the first mile Riege got after it as he was among the top 20 racers before fading slightly. The field separated over the next mile, but he stayed among the top half.


In between, he got spiked on his right leg.

"Every turn broke you down a little bit," Riege said. "There was a lot of good competition today. I couldn't have asked for a better race, though."

The tough, fast field featured 37 runners finish in less than 15 minutes. Riege hopes to join that group next year.

"I want to do better," Riege said.

Ault earns All-State finish:

Setting a goal of finishing 25th or better in 15:30 or less at the Class 1A state meet, Monmouth-Roseville senior Nathan Ault accomplished both. Ault crossed the finish line in a 25th-place time of 15:29, which was the last All-State spot.

"Everything worked out," Ault said. "I couldn't be happier."

Ault becomes the second All-State finisher in program history and first since 2012.

"I met most of my goals," Ault said. "I had a great team to back me up. I can't think of a better finish."

Mercer County senior Austin Jackson placed 64th overall in 16:05.

"I'm satisfied," Jackson said. "I gave it my best, and I know that. I don't think today was my highlight, but I gave it my best."

Kewanee junior Rolando Aguilar was 41st overall, finishing in 15:53. Monmouth-Roseville senior Jesus Corrales took 105th place in 16:29.

In the team race, Mid-County took 12th with 354 points. The Cougars were led by Ethan Stanley (28th, 15:36.91), Bryent VanDeWos-tine (40th, 15:51.79) and Mike Bersell (109th, 16:33.17).

2A State Finals Recap

Peoria, Ill – In most of the races that Jake & Luke Hoffert (Yorkville HS) have run against 2A competition this season, they force the pace and dare you to come after them. It was the opposite for the two in the 2A Boys race on Saturday afternoon at the IHSA State Cross Country Meet at Detweiller Park. In the end, the outcome was the same.

Jake Hoffert broke away in the final 500 meters to capture the individual state championship running 14:30. His brother Luke was close behind only one second back. “He just outkicked me at the end,” Luke said of his brother Jake. “The one ending race of my career I wanted to beat him.”

The two Yorkville runners again took the lead going by the half mile in 2:15. Caleb Hummer (Danville HS) and Shane Williamson (Vernon Hills HS) followed behind. Jake & Luke along with Hummer went by the mile in 4:43 with one second back. It was evident that Hummer was not going to go away quietly. The race pack was three seconds behind the quartet.

Williamson was starting to fade but only two seconds back behind the trio as passed the 2 mile in 9:43. Instead of the Hofferts pushing the pace, Hummer went ahead to force the issue. As they turned north along Route 29, Hummer took off using the gentle decline to his advantage opening up a 15 meter lead. "I didn't think I was going to catch him. He made a strong move with 1200 meters to go," Jake said.

Hummer still had that 15 meter lead as he passed the entrance and exit of the triangle. Just before the he made the final three point turn on the course to head for home, Hummer's lead started to shrink as he was feeling the effects of his early move. The Hofferts moved as the made the s-curve to head down the final stretch. Hummer did what he had do in the race. Now he was paying the price in the final stretch. Williamson, Alex Keeble (Mahomet-Seymour HS), and Colin DeYoung (Illiana Christian HS, Lansing) all passed Hummer in the final 20 meters as he finished. It was still all-state but not the place that he wanted.

"I went out there and gave it my all," Hummer told Chad Dare of the *Danville Commercial News*. "I was the only one that wanted to compete with the Hofferts today. So I was force to run their race. I tried as hard as I could. I tried to win it, unfortunately, that wasn't the case today."

"The twins ran a patient race, their race, and didn't panic when Hummer made his moves. They are great leaders and veteran runners that set a great tone for the rest of the boys this week," said Yorkville Coach Chris Muth. "It was a joy to see the Hoffert boys develop over the last four years. It's very rare to get a pair of such hard working kids who are so humble and come with such a great family. They are a great pair and any college that gets them next year will be better off because of them."

The 1-2 finish by the two brothers was a big plus for the fortunes of the Foxes. Yorkville won the Boys Team title to compete the 2A team sweep in Boys and Girls. They scored 105 points to out distance Mahomet-Seymour and Illiana Christian. Trevor Willis (29th), Zack Price (53rd), and Alexx Nauman (64th) were the other runners in the top five that helped Yorkville their second team title in a row.

"In the past two weeks Trevor as our three, has really broken out and established himself as a quality runner in his own right and nothing was different at the state meet, he ran within his abilities and was strong throughout," added Muth. "This week's 4 and 5 runners were both very young runners in freshman Zack Price and sophomore Alexx Nauman who have worked really hard all year and it was just a matter of time before everything started to click for them. We knew they were upcoming talent, but were extremely excited to see the times they posted on such a big stage, as well as it being their first state experiences."

Mahomet-Seymour capped off a great season with a second place finish scoring 134 points. The Bulldogs had two all-state runners leading the way with Keeble's 4th place finish and William Wolf finishing 18th. "Our 2014 team did well in my opinion because they genuinely care a lot about each other," said Mahomet-Seymour Coach Neal Garrison. "They encourage and motivate each other all year. As a coach it was tough to limit our State team to 7 runners as we had 9 runners who had run in the top 5 throughout the season."

Illiana Christian captured their second consecutive top three trophy with a third place finish paced by all-state runs by Colin DeYoung (5th) and Nick Wondaal (9th). Springfield did not get on the podium but ran their best team race of the season to place fourth scoring 187 points. They were 15 points behind Illiana Christian.

1A State Finals Recap



Monticello's inner pack key to 1st 1A team championship

Peoria, Ill – The only competition that Jon Davis (Oakwood HS, Fithian) had in the final stages in the 1A Boys race at the IHSA State Cross Country Meet at Detweiller Park was the pace truck. Even the motorized vehicle had trouble staying ahead of the swift legs of the Oakwood junior.

"In the last 400 meters, regardless of the pain, I had to keep on trucking," Davis said. "I pretended that the truck was in first and it was going to beat me. I just gave it my all."

Davis used the carrot of a Class 1A record and the truck to capture his second straight state championship and his fourth overall state crown in Cross Country and Track & Field Saturday Morning. Davis finished in 14:20 missing Jeremy Stevens' record by only two seconds. His margin of victory was an incredible 42 seconds ahead of second place Eric Ponder (Tuscola HS) and Tanner Chada (Aurora Christian HS).

This race mirrored races from the sectional meet of a week ago and the regional meet two weeks ago where Davis moved away from Ponder before the half way point of the race. The same thing happened in this state race. Ponder

got off to a great start having the lead past the 400. Davis caught the Tuscola senior just before the half as they passed the half in 2:15. The duo passed the mile point together in 4:45 running side by side.

Davis picked up the pace as he entered the triangle passing the halfway point in 7:04. By the time he passed the 2 mile point in 9:39, he had opened up a 20 second lead on a struggling Ponder. Chada, who was nine seconds behind Ponder at the mile, had closed the gap to four seconds catching Ponder after the turn behind the starting line.

Davis was struggling as he entered the last half mile. He knew he wanted the record. He put his head down and went. He fell short by two seconds of the record but ran the last half mile in an incredible 2:08.

"I had to dig inside of myself to finish that last oomph," added Davis. "That 2:08 last half mile speaks for itself."

Ponder held off Chada in the final stretch to grab second place ahead of the Aurora Christian sophomore.

"I thought I may be able to keep up with him at the mile," Ponder said. "He made that move when we went into the triangle. My thought was I could have one of it. I'm proud of second actually. I knew that Davis was a tough competitor. I have track season. I can get him in track."

Monticello came in as the team favorite in this race and failed to disappoint. The Sages placed their five scoring runners in the first 53 to win their 1st state championship with 93 points. Matt Norvell was Monticello's first and only runner in the first 25. He earned all-state honors by finishing 13th overall. They had an overall split of 40 seconds. Following Norvell was Justin Furich (26th), Zach Mesplay (29th), James Kilby (33rd), and Will Montgomery (53rd). The key for success for their state championship was only a nine second split between Furich and Kilby.

"I think we all believed that we had a shot at the title, but I don't believe you can come into this meet with any kind of expectation," said Monticello coach Dave Remmert. "We were very deliberate this season though about not focusing on others, just on ourselves and doing the things we needed to do to prepare. I could sense an eagerness about the team during the week and I felt like mentally they were in a good place leading into Saturday. We were healthy and rested, and the kids performed very well under the pressure. I couldn't be happier about their performance."

2013 champion Elmwood-Brimfield ran their best race of the season but had to settle for second place with 143 points. Matt Osmulski (12th) and Nate Herridge (17th) earned all-state status.

Rockford Christian won a close battle for third in which only 11 points separated third through fifth place. Nick Monkemeyer led the Royal Lions with a fourth place finish. "We were very pleased. Our depth carried us. Alex Wilfong who has finished in our top 5 all year was really sick and struggled at state as we thought he might. He's a four time letterman and earned the right to try. Josiah Vogel actually fractured his leg in the race and had to DNF. He's a great kid and will make an impact for future RC squads," said Rockford Christian Coach Randy Moore. "The boys knew we had changed some training to peak better at state and they did. It is a huge confidence boost for all of us. I challenged the boys to live out three legacies this season: personal, team, and spiritual. I do believe they honored Christ in all three."

Tolono Unity was five points behind in fourth place with 162 points. Winnebago finished fifth behind all-state runs by Nathan Smith (9th) and Nathan Ambrose (11th).



3A State Finals Recap



Hinsdale Central's second straight title worth the wait.

Peoria, Ill – Jesse Reiser (McHenry HS) knew that he would have to give it all to win the individual state championship. He was totally exhausted last season when he finished second behind O'Fallon's Patrick Perrier's win. Anyone who has run the state meet at Detweiller Park knows that you have to be in the best shape of your life both physically and mentally when you stepped to that starting line.

Reiser showed that Saturday in the 3A Boys race at the IHSA State Cross Country Meet. He pulled away from a pack of 10 runners in the last half mile and stormed across the finish line state champ in 14:11. This 3A race was not like no other state race that I have seen. There is usually a defined pack of a couple of runners after the half-way point. That was not the case in this meet. There was the huge pack at the mile that you normally see in every state meet. There up front was the usual suspects. Reiser, Zach Dale (Conant HS, Hoffman Estates), Ryan Clevenger (Downers Grove North HS), Matt Pereira (Lake Zurich HS), Sam Oh (Stevenson HS, Lincolnshire), Blake Evertsen (Central HS, Hinsdale), Kevin Salvano (Buffalo Grove HS), Keagan Smith (Huntley HS), Dorrian Gordon (O'Fallon HS), and Chris Buechner (Glenbard West HS, Glen Ellyn) all went through the mile in 4:45 with at least 60 runners within 5 seconds of the lead.

There was no separation in the triangle of this pack. No one was willing to put their cards on the table yet. The pace was slowing down as they went through the 1 ½ mile point in 7:13 and the 2 mile in 9:45. The pace was slower than the two previous Boys races run on this day. As they turned the corner going behind the starting line, no one blinked. No one budged in that pack.

As they made the turn to cross the field with a half mile to go, Reiser bolted to the lead trying to break the pack. Dale stayed right on Reiser's shoulder refusing to lose contact. Pereira, Clevenger, and Gordon were following close behind.

"At that moment, I was not sure that he (Dale) was going to have an extra kick in him in that last 400 meters," Reiser said. "I felt when I moved (with a half mile to go), that was already my kick. I thought I could not go faster than that. In the last 400 meters, it was all out."

When you run for a state championship, you dig deep inside of yourself to find that extra 33% to make it to the end. Reiser and Dale did just that with Reiser having a little more. He opened up 10 seconds on Dale in the final 500 meters to win in 14:11. Dale crossed the line second exhausted in 14:21.

"I've never experienced so much pain at the end of a race before than I did today," Reiser added. "It was pure happiness. All the work has finally paid off in these four years. This is what it is all about." Reiser move at the end was one for the ages. He ran the last mile in a quick 4:27.

"I did not think there would be that many people at 2 miles. It was state so I knew it was possible," Dale said after the awards. "We had six guys with us in that last half mile. I was sitting back the whole race just trying to stay calm. I knew I could close pretty hard. I got close to Jesse and pushed it a lot. I wanted to put it all out there and I definitely did."

Matt Pereira was one second back in third place. Two seconds behind came Ryan Clevenger. Then Kevin Salvano was next finishing fifth running his best race of the year. Lost in the pack was the performance of York freshman Charlie Kern. He was 25th at the two mile point seven seconds behind the lead pack. He stormed down the final straight only to be passed by Connor Horn (Neuqua Valley HS, Naperville) in the final few meters to finish eighth overall. His time of 14:36 was just one second behind the time run by 3 time state champ Jorge Torres did when he was a freshman. The future looks extremely bright for this York youngster.

The talk heading into this meet was the performance of Sandburg at the Marist Sectional Meet the Saturday before when they easily won the team championship ahead of a field where the top four ranked teams in the state was there. Hinsdale Central was in second that race and had to recover quickly to get ready for the state competition on Saturday.

"We felt last week that we just needed to get through the sectional however it plays out. The following week we just had to get back to the grind," Hinsdale Central Jim Westphal said. "We needed to get that momentum back. We felt after conference with Matt McBrien's injury to his foot and Chris Brenk's IT Band injury, you start to think if the wheels are coming off. We just went back to the basics. We ran 800's on Monday collectively. Each day last week became more positive."

The key in the state meet is usually the first 800 and getting around the first hairpin turn where some hopes in the race come to die if you are caught on the inside. "The thing that killed us today is that we did not get the job done in the first 800 meters," said Sandburg coach John O'Malley. Sandburg started out of Box 8 getting pinched on the inside at the turn. "500 Meters in I was wondering what did we just do. We were buried at that point. I think our first guy was in the 80's."

The top four teams in the state and from the sectional (Sandburg, Hinsdale Central, Neuqua Valley, and Lyons Township) were again the teams to watch and it showed during the race. The scores were announced at each check point with at first Sandburg in the lead, then Hinsdale Central taking over. Lyons Township and Neuqua Valley were fighting for the finish and a trophy.

It was so close at the finish as runners were coming across the line 5 a breast. It took 45 minutes for meet officials to go through the video to correctly determine the exact place. Hinsdale Central stood together as a group standing by the board waiting for the results. Other teams and coaches were comparing notes wondering who would end up on top.

Finally, Hinsdale Central got the signal from the officials' trailer that they had repeated as the state champs. A huge cheer followed by joyous celebration. Tears were flowing among the Hinsdale runners celebrating the obstacles that they had overcome the past few weeks. There was not a dry eye in that area.

"Last year, York got sick right before the state meet. It was out of there control. This year, Sandburg was full force as you could see by the sectional results," Hinsdale Central junior Chris Brenk said. "We knew that this state meet had to be a fair fight. We were both at full strength. It was a fair fight."

"Honestly, I was tearing up just trying to hold my tears back," Hinsdale senior Griffin Gartner added. "I just wanted results to see how well we worked together."

Hinsdale Central's state championship was won with 104 points and three all-state runners. The performances of Josh Feldman and Griffin Gartner were the difference in the Red Devils capturing their second straight championship. Hinsdale did get top 25 performances by Blake Everts (12th, first man) and Chris Brenk (25th, third man) that were expected. Josh Feldman stepped up and ran his best race of his life placing 22nd running 14:50 as the team's second man. The same could be said of Griffin Gartner who finished 43rd just ahead of teammate Alex Domiano as the team's 4th/5th man. Gartner did not run cross country his freshman year. He was a converted football player and ran the sprints in track in the spring. During the season, Gartner was normally the team's sixth runner. He stepped up at the right moment when his team needed him.

"Our goal was just to go out and execute. If we finished third, we would be very happy. Whatever we placed and ran our tail off, we would be happy," Westphal concluded. "Last year was new the emotions we had after the meet. This year it was different because our perspective was different. I think it was equally as fun. Griffin Gartner was crying afterwards because in his senior year, he came through for his teammates. It was tears of joy."

Sandburg's start at the beginning hurt their team chances. It showed as they finished second with 138 points. Their split was only 11 seconds, but their pack was outside of the top 25. Tom Brennan was the team's first finisher placing 31st. It was the first time that this Sandburg program has won a trophy at the state meet. A great accomplishment but not the trophy that they wanted.

"I would like to say that second was satisfying but no. I am satisfied with whatever they are satisfied," O'Malley added. "I just hurt for them. When you live and die by high expectations, it's the only way you are going to be great. Sometimes it hurts but that is the risk of trying."

Perhaps one of the best team performances of the day was that of Lyons Township. The only people that might have believed that the Lions would be in the top three was the team, their coaches, and their followers after they finished fifth last week at Marist. Just like last season when they finished fourth, Lyons Township ran their best race of the season to place third with 180 points. Junior Connor Madell led his team with a 15th place finish. Lyons Township had a 36 second split on their five scoring runners.

Neuqua Valley finished fourth missing a trophy by only one point. The Wildcats had two all-state runners with Horn's seventh place finish and the 18th place finish by senior Michael Widmann. Daniel Weiss finished 28th as Neuqua's third man.

Glenbard West finished fifth despite the fact that two of their runners fell in the first 100 meters of the race. The Hilltoppers did have Chris Buechner as an all-state runner as he finished 19th.

The other team performance that would have to be noted was that of the sixth place finish of York. The Dukes have that standard of being a top three team every season. This season has been a down one for the Dukes. They were on life support after they barely made it out of the Niles West Sectional on a fifth place tie. They ran their best race of the year to get 6th. Some coaches after the race noted to me that this could have been legendary Coach Joe Newton's best coaching jobs for this meet. I would have to agree.


