SENIOR CO-CAPTAINS LEAD THE WAY IN SEASON OPENING WIN

On Tuesday, August 25th, the Leafs traveled to Sterling's Hoover Park for the annual Sterling Grass Relays. The race uses the unique format of pairing two teammates who take turns running the one mile loop. The total racing distance is 6 miles (3 miles each.) I stole the idea from Kenny Klipp years ago. Our course isn't conducive for the format (too hilly) so I asked the Sterling Staff if they would be willing to host this meet. They smiled and said, "Sure!" The rest is history as we have moved into our 2nd decade of this meet.

The weatherman was kind to us for late August with a daytime high of only 72° with a light wind. The course was hard and fast and the team ran great. We haven't done any speed work yet (our goal is to PEAK during CHAMPIONSHIP MEET SEASON) so this is the fasted running the men have done (other than some striders.) Coach Moe and I selected the pairings and then let the

Sterling has a very strong team and is ranked higher than us in the State Rankings. Currently, we have greater depth and that is what carried the day for us (remember...the top 5 scorers is actually 10 men due to the pairing.) The Leafs grabbed 6 of the top 9 spots with senior Captains Gabe Johnson and Charley Elden grabbing 2nd place to lead the Leafs. Not far behind were the teams of: Nathan Sorian & Peter Rizzo (3rd); Kaden Rink & Andrew Rizzo (5th); Charlie Schlindwein & Keith Elden (7th); Nathan Carroll & Kyle Sellers (8th); and Chandler Schwartz & Blake Duncan (9th.) Also running strong were the teams of: Cameron Darin & Christian Booth (12th); Sam Murray & Keegan Banister (13th); Keaton Darin & Ethan Baumgardner (14th); Nelson Laingen & Nathan Lambert (15th); Brandon Ramos & Adam Wells (16th); Nik Floyd & Thackery Newton (17th); Maguire Hoon & Cole Schwerdt (18th); Kris Nguyen & Juan Mejias-Dansbach (20th); Bo Lindstrom & Elliott Moore (21st); and Nathan Stanfield & Nathan Konvicka (23rd.) We had one extra man so Tristan Johnson started each of his reps with Brandon Ramos.

It was awesome to watch us line up 16 TEAMS (highly motivated teams, by the way!) The Seniors did a great job of warming up the team (same for the cool-down.) 
