### **LEAFS 10TH AT NORMAL UNIVERSITY HIGH SCHOOL SECTIONAL**

On Saturday, October 31st, the Leafs traveled to Normal's Maxwell Park to participate in the Normal University High School 2A Sectional Meet. Teams that qualified for the meet included: Bartonville (Limestone), Danville, Dunlap, Geneseo, LaSalle-Peru, Lincolnway West, Metamora, Mohomet-Seymore, Morris, Morton, Normal University High School, Normal West, Ottawa, Peoria Notre Dame, New Lenox (Providence Catholic), Rock Island (Alleman), Streator, and Washington. In addition, the top 5 boys from the Crete Monee Regional, East Peoria Regional, and Peoria Notre Dame Regionals not on the six advancing teams qualified as individuals. On the line was a trip to the State Finals next Saturday at Detweiller Park in Peoria. The top 5 teams and the top 7 individuals not on the 5 advancing teams would qualify for the State Meet.

The weatherman wasn't kind to us as he gave us a race time temperature of 47° with 25 to 30 mile per hour winds. Add to that a cold rain and you have a challenging day. To put it mildly, it was a MUDDER!. Coach Phillip Moe along with senior team captains Charley Elden and Gabe Johnson did a great job of keeping the team in a positive frame of mind. A frame of mind that had them believing that these conditions were to our advantage. Truer words have never been spoken. With 4 of the State of Illinois 2A top 10 ranked teams on the line there was little room for error. Add to that SEVEN additional teams that had their goal of punching a State Meet Ticket as their goal. The Leafs were among that group.



The gun cracked at 11:00 a.m. sharp and had the cream of the crop rolling into a huge lead pack that held together for almost two miles. Leaf Junior Nathan Soria was in that group. Behind him were team packs of Senior Charley Elden and Freshman Kaden Rink followed by our 2nd pack that included: Senior Gabe Johnson, Sophomore Blake Duncan, and Freshmen Twinkies Andrew and Peter Rizzo. The boys followed up last week's Regional performance (the best of the season) by topping that effort as they ROARED. When the dust had settled, Nathan had sprinted home in a State Meet qualifying place of 11th in an impressive 15:46 over the mud-soaked course. Next up were Freshman Kaden Rink and Senior Charley Elden who sprinted home in 48th and 52nd places respectfully. Charley was racing on a sprained ankle (rolled it at the Regional Meet) and Kaden has been battling a groin issue for about a month. After that Senior Gabe Johnson, Sophomore Blake Duncan, Freshman Andrew Rizzo, and Freshman Peter Rizzo sprinted home in 77th, 81st, 82nd, and 83rd places respectfully. Each man was totally spent with their efforts and held their heads high with pride knowing they could have done no more. Nathan summed it up perfectly while being interviewed by the Moline Dispatch Newspaper when he said he knew we had run well when he saw his teammates walking towards him, arm in arm.

Everyone was drenched and we hit the cool down (actually trying to warm up) as soon as we could. Charley was, unable to run on his ankle and was left behind with an ice pack and a blanket. It took a long time for the results to be posted (the IHSA has to review the entire race via video before posting the official results.) We hoped that it was enough. When the results were finally posted, we had placed 10th in this loaded field. We are extremely proud of each man's effort. We are also proud of the support that the four alternates provided. After the awards ceremony, we headed to my FAVORITE restaurant (Avanti's). After parking our white bus and changing into some dry clothing, I found the team huddled in the restroom using the hand dryer blower to try to warm up. I must admit that this was very creative and effective. Following our meal we headed home knowing that our season continues via Nathan Soria's qualifying. As far as the team goes.....NEXT YEAR that darn door is going to get kicked down. It is hard to believe that it has been 16 years since a Maple Leaf Boys team toed the line at the State Meet. Dream Big, Men and then "talk with your feet" and pay the dues that qualifying requires. # Nothing holding Soria back

## from state

Geneseo's Nathan Soria was thinking about just one thing — his first state berth.

With a brutal rain washing over the course during the boys' cross country 2A Normal University Sectional, Soria was focused on his goal and didn't let the past be a factor in his mind on Oct. 31.

Last season, Soria was on the outside looking in, just 10 seconds removed from the final qualifying spot.

This season, the Maple Leafs junior wouldn't be denied.

Soria finished in 11th place with a blistering time of 15:46 to claim one of seven qualifying spots for the 2A IHSA state meet at Detweiller Park in Peoria starting at noon.

"Last year, I was so close and it was tough," Soria said. "I worked all summer knowing I was that close and knowing I wanted to make it this year. It was really cool to finally do it this year."

Soria slipped and fell twice in wet conditions at regionals last season.

However, he didn't let the past affect the way he attacked the course at Maxwell Park in Normal, while a steady rain turned to a downpour.

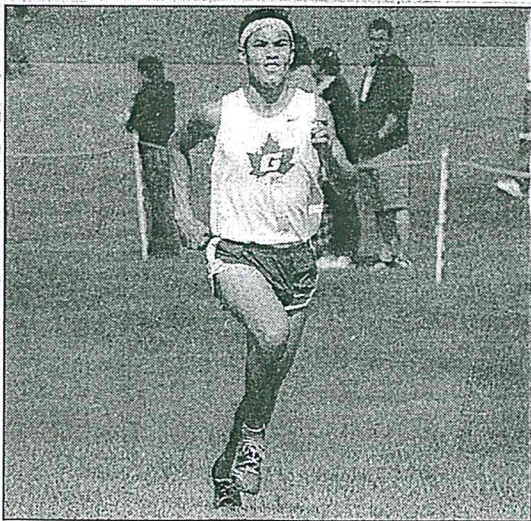

In fact, it never really occurred to him until after.

"He's a gamer," Geneseo coach Don Fredericks said. "When the stakes are the highest, he is at his best."

Soria becomes the first Geneseo runner to advance to state since Jordan Starkey in 2012.

The 2A state race will be on Saturday, Nov. 7 and

is slated for noon.

With the top five teams advancing to state, the Maple Leafs' team finished 10th (242) in the standings with Mahomet-Seymour winning the sectional title (65).

The individual sectional champion was Jack Franklin (15:13) from Normal University.

A freshman, Geneseo's Kaden Rink clocked in at 16:44 and nabbed 48th place.

Charley Elden wasn't far behind in 52nd place (16:46), and Gabe Johnson finished 77th (17:00).

Geneseo's Blake Duncan landed in 81st (17:02).

The Leafs' Andrew and Peter Rizzo were nearly identical finishing 82nd and 83rd respectively in 17:03.

While it is his first trip to state in cross country, Soria has experience running at state as a member of the Maple Leafs' track team and was a part of the fifth place 4x800-relay team this past season.

Having a great experience at state track made him even more motivated him to put in the summer work to recapture the same feeling again during cross country season.

"We had a great team this year," Soria said. "I think getting down to state will get us all motivated. I think we have a good chance next season."



# Geneseo girls' pair, Alleman's Golding punch state tickets

**NORMAL** — Looking to grasp an analogy for his Geneseo boys' cross country team after its top-10 finish in the tough Class 2A Normal Sectional, Coach Don Fredericks had one right at hand. Actually both hands.

Fredericks, trying to stay warm on a wet and chilly Saturday morning at Maxwell Park, was sporting his Chicago Cubs gloves.

"We have three freshmen, a sophomore, a junior and two seniors, so maybe this is like the Cubs where great things happen a year earlier than expected," Fredericks said after his Maple Leafs places 10th as a team, with the top five advancing to next Saturday's state finals. "We had been struggling all season trying to put it all together, and then last Saturday happened, where they ran their best of the season" at their regional meet.

Best among the Leafs was Nathan Soria, the junior, who placed 11th individually and qualified for state in a time of 15:46. He came down the home stretch with a kick that he had hoped had top-10 written on it.

"I had top-10 adrenaline right there," said Soria. "I came around the turn and tried as hard as I could, passing two guys down the stretch."

Alleman, which placed seventh in the field — two spots out of qualifying the Pioneers as a team for state — also has one individual advance to next week's state competition at Detweiller Park in Peoria. Aaron Golding, a senior, was the last of the top seven individuals not on a

qualifying team to become state-bound. Golding had a time of 15:57.

Alleman had a pair of runners barely miss out on advancing to state. Spencer Smith was 6.5 seconds behind Golding's qualifying time, placing 19th, three spots behind his teammate. Augie Darrow was seven-tenths of a second behind Smith.

Ben Weaver, at 16:57.9, and Connor Sheley, at 17:21.1, contributed to Alleman's seventh-place finish.

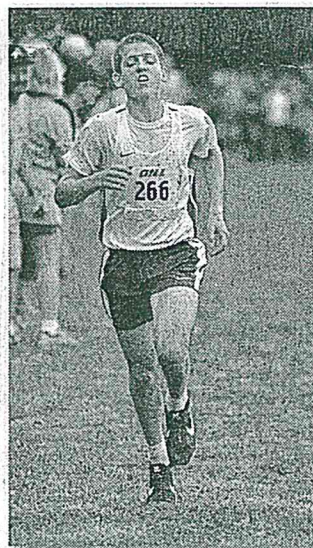
The best part for Soria came when he was returning to the nearby Geneseo tent. In front of him, were his teammates, arms around each other, side by side by side.

"When I saw that, I knew that they had come in together. That was just awesome," Soria said.

The lead Leaf said he had to emerge out of a pack of 25 runners from what Fredericks called the toughest sectional in the state — "and that's true maybe for the 3A as well," he added — with the front runners pared to eight a mile and a half in. Soria said he was trailing those and knew he needed his finishing kick.

Soria's top-four teammates were separated by 18 seconds — Kaden Rink 16:44.2; Charley Elden 16:46.3; Gabe Johnson 17:00.5; and Blake Duncan 17:02.5.

"Four of the top 10 teams in the state are in the sectional," Fredericks noted, rattling off No. 1 Mahomet-Seymour, No. 5 Normal U-High, No. 8 Metamora and No. 10 Peoria Notre Dame. PND and Metamora flip-flopped on the top-four sectional finish, with Mahomet and Normal U-High as the top two. "I am very

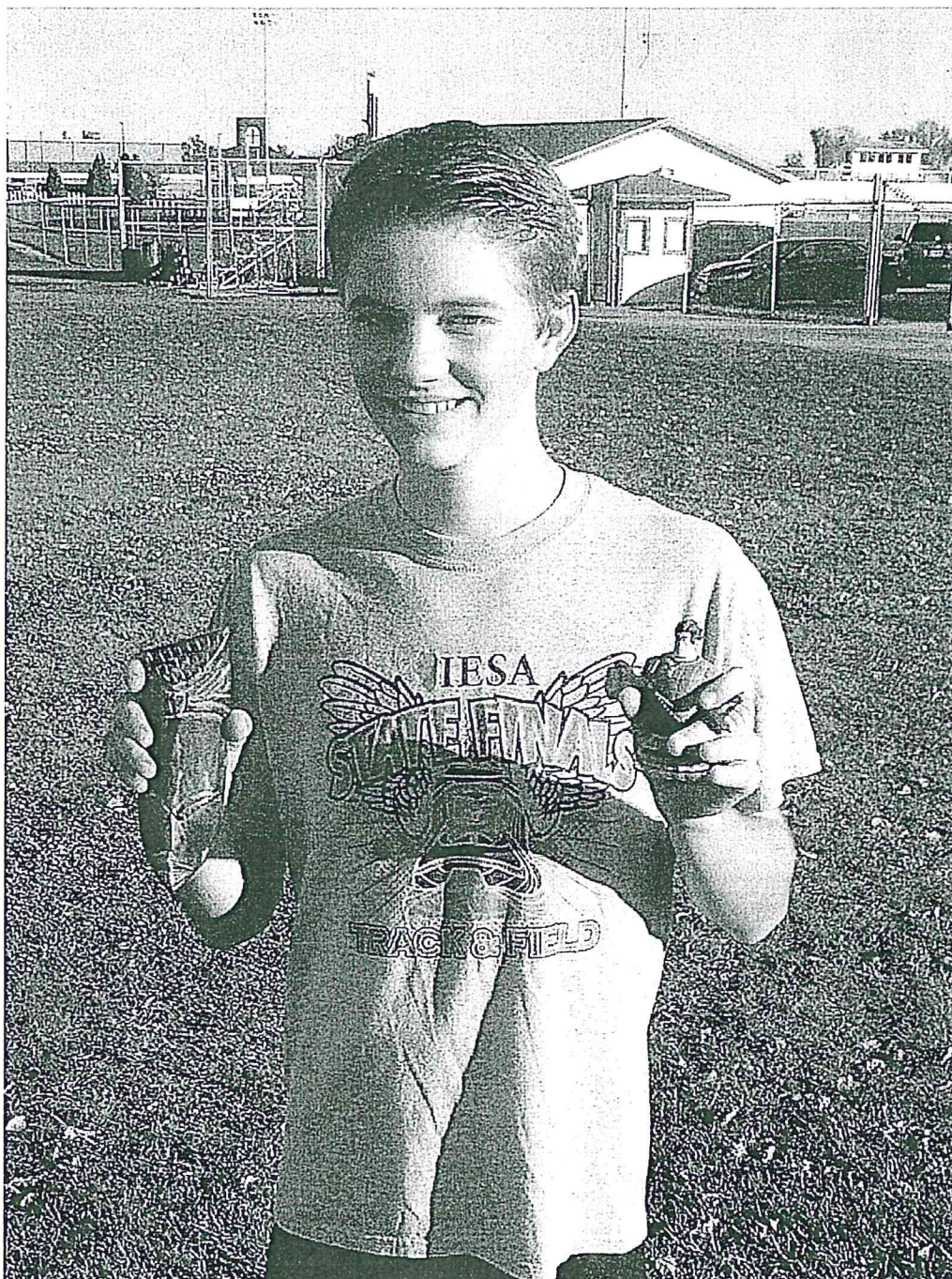
