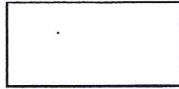

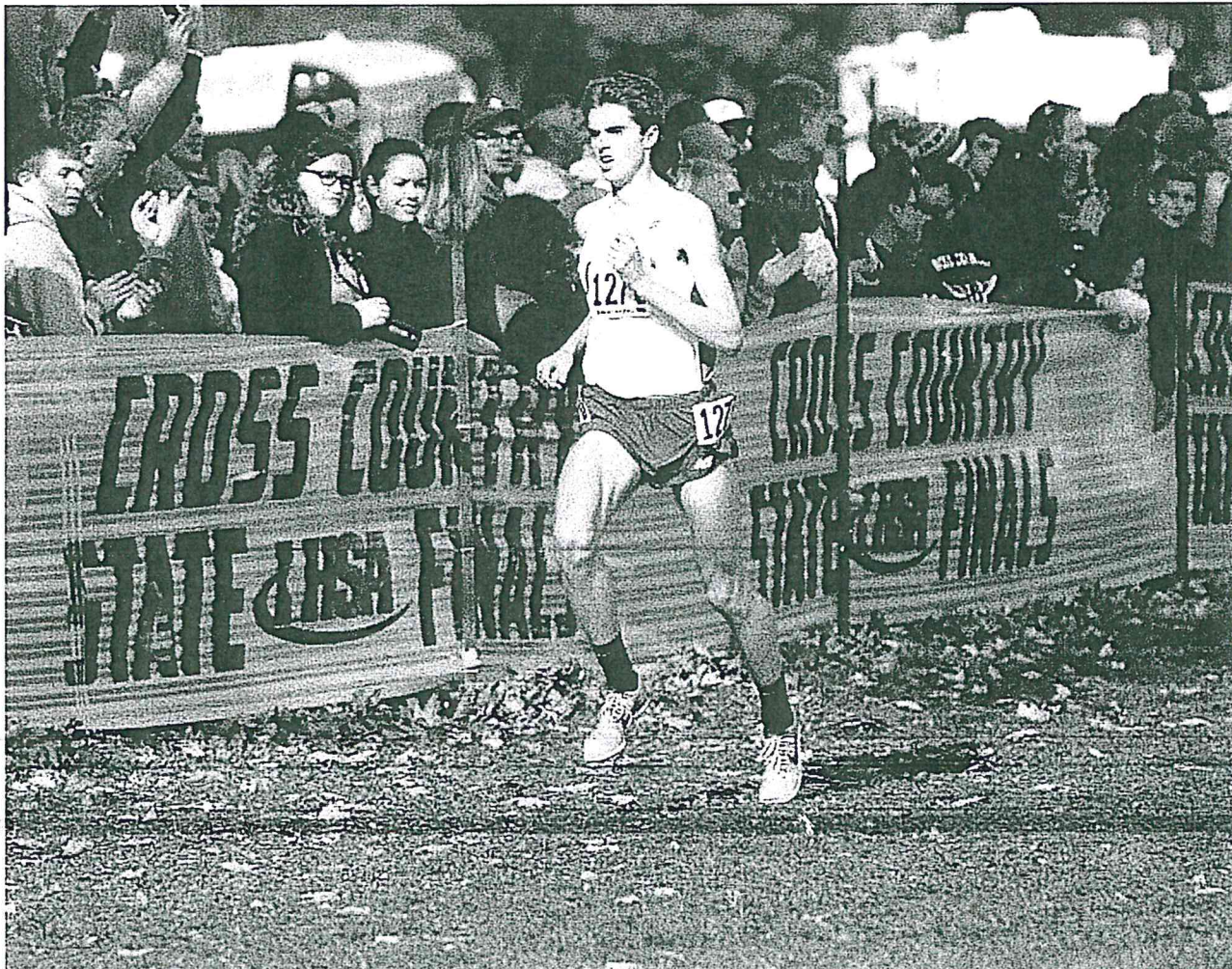

Jack & Matt Aho finish 1-2; Jenna Lutzow leads Belvidere North to 2A Girls State Championship

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Peoria --- It was tough for the Mahomet-Seymour Boys team to grasp their second place finish in this race a year ago. Maybe it was fuel for the fire within them this entire season as they turned in some remarkable performances. The biggest one came in Saturday's 2A Boys race as they placed 7 runners in the first 27 to capture their first state championship with only 58 points. Defending champion Grayslake Central (134 points) was second followed by Normal University (188 points). Sterling (194 points) missed the awards podium by only 6 points.

The story of the race was just how well the Mahomet-Seymour pack stayed together. They had all 7 runners in the first 35 places at the mile. From that point on, they just moved up from there. Their split on their top five runners was only 23 seconds. On all seven runners, it was a miniscule 31 seconds.

"It was fun for me as a coach to see so many of them earn All-State status. Our runners worked very hard for years to set themselves up for success. I am very proud of them both as runners and people. They have tremendous character. They are disciplined in their running so it was great to watch them get rewarded in such a big race," Mahomet-Seymour Coach Neal Garrison said. "I am fortunate to have two volunteer coaches (Gary Garrison and Todd Lafond). They have helped our program develop so much over the years. I also owe my alumni a lot for setting us up for success. They say overnight success usually took 10 years. We had well over 10 years of alumni helping us improve gradually over the years to where we could win a State trophy to represent them. But most of the credit for the team really has to go to God. I have no off-season training program. Instead, I pray that God will provide me with the right runners on our team. I put my total trust in God to give me the right runners. On the first day of practice I work with what I am provided. God has really blessed me with a tremendous group. We have 18 runners on our team and all of them are exceptional young men. I could not have picked a better group myself. It has very little to do with any fancy workouts I create in the fall. It has everything to do with God blessing our team with great young men."

Andrew Wallmer led the way with a 6th place finished. He was followed by Riley Fortune (13th), Mathias Powell (18th), Ryan Hodge (19th), Brian Butcher (21st), and Ben Craw 24th) as all-state runners. Gabe Pommier was the team's 7th runner in 27th place. Mahomet-Seymour is the third team in IHSA history to have 6 all-state runners preceded by St. Joseph-Ogden (1991) and York (1999).

Jack Aho had been down this road before in last year's state meet. This race was a little different. He had a pack of his brother Matt, Jack Franklin (Normal University HS), Matt Richtman (Kaneland HS, Maple Park), and Jacob Gephardt (Sterling HS) with him at the mile as the group passed in a quick 4:42. Aho took a look back to see who was with him. As he entered the triangle, he started to push the pace a little

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Aho's lead grew as he approached the final 400 meters. He defended his title crossing the line in a personal best 14:11. He turned around and waited to see what was transpiring behind him. There was a battle for second as Franklin, Matt Aho, and Barkocy traded off the second spot. In the final 200 meters Matt made a move crossing the finish line in second (14:26) and in to his brother Jack's arms who was hoping for that moment. It was the second time a pair of siblings finished 1-2. Jake and Luke Hoffert accomplished it two years before this day.

"This feels a million times better than last year," Jack said with his brother by his side. "It felt incredible. It feels so much better the second time. Seeing my teammates cross the line last year was great when we got the title. But seeing him across the line today, its two memories that I will never forget."

The finishes by the Aho's and a 12th place finish by Eli Minsky pushed Grayslake Central into second place. Normal University was led by Franklin's 3rd place finish and the 11th place finish by Jared Shuckman.

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The 2A Girls race was looked at as a battle of two separate match-ups. There was the individual race between NIC-10 rivals Jenna Lutzow (Belvidere North HS) and Delaney Appino (Boylan Catholic HS). There was the battle between the two evenly matched top ranked teams Belvidere North and Dunlap. Appino pushed the pace from the start trying to distance herself from Lutzow as early as possible. She passed the mile in 5:28 with Lutzow only 2 seconds back. The Belvidere North senior was not going to let her get away.

Lutzow was even with Appino as the two runners passed 2 miles in 11:06. It was now Lutzow's turn to make a move. It was one that Appino could not reply to. Lutzow charged away in the final 800 to win in a personal best 16:35. Appino was 10 seconds back in second place. Appino's teammate Grace McLaughlin ran 17:10 to finish third.

"Coming up that incline, I was going to stay strong and finish no matter how much it hurt," Lutzow said. "I crossed the line I was so tired. But I realized that I just did it."

Along with Lutzow's individual win came a state championship for Belvidere North. The Blue Thunder's three runners in the first eleven off set the 34 second split by Dunlap to edge the Eagles 61-79.

Freshmen Madison Diercks (4<sup>th</sup>) and Gianna Sagona crossed the line as Belvidere North's second and third runners. Olivia Zaluckyj (40<sup>th</sup>), Sabrina Elder (41<sup>st</sup>), and Alexandria Reza (42<sup>nd</sup>) came in with only a second separating the trio. Dunlap was led by all-state performances by Franny Verville (13<sup>th</sup>), Abby Johnson (23<sup>rd</sup>), and Ayah Aldadah (25<sup>th</sup>).

Vernon Hills ran a great race to finish third with 95 points and only a 44 second split on their scorers

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# Rock Falls' Hamblen Wins Title

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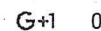
Where there was no drama in the finish of the Girls race, it was a different story an hour later in the 1. Boys Race. Wyatt McIntyre (Athens HS) had raced (Brayden Hamblen (Rock Falls HS) in September on this course. Hamblen pulled away from McIntyre in the final mile to win the race. McIntyre was not going to allow that to happen in this race. He pulled away in the back triangle opening up a 9 second lead at the 2 mile point. It looked like the race was basically over. As the race turned onto the Route 29 portion of the course, Hamblen dug deep to find a reserve of strength that he did not think he had.

Hamblen had closed the gap to four seconds with 800 meters to go. By the time that the lead pace truck made the final turn for the last 300 meters of the race, the two runners were even. Hamblen finally pushed his way to the front with 150 meters to go. He raised his arms in disbelief as he neared the finish line. He ran almost a 20 second personal best of 14:22 to win the state championship. McIntyre was only three seconds back in second. There were two more runners that finished under 15 minutes in this race. Logan Hall (Arthur Lovington HS) ran a personal best of 14:44 to finish third. Tanner Chada (Hinckley – Big Rock HS) also achieved a personal best (14:54) in finishing fourth.

"I was sitting back with Logan and Tanner and I knew I had to make a move because I knew that he (McIntyre) was not going to drop it off," Hamblen said. "In the last mile there is so much adrenaline. I just had to give it everything I had."

Harvest Christian Academy ran to their first state championship in the school's history with only a nine point margin ahead of second place Freeburg (107-116). The Lions had two all-state runners with Andrew Dobrescu (20th) and Michael Sisko (22nd) crossing the line with the same time (15:29). Payton Kasper (36th), Mark Davilla (55th), and Kyler Young (61st) were the team's other scorers. The split on their scorers was only 35 seconds. Freeburg also had two all-state runners with Charlie Parrish finishing 13th and Alex Mack placing 16th overall. Richmond-Burton finished third (138 points) behind Ryan Hommowun and his 9th place finish.

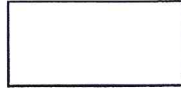

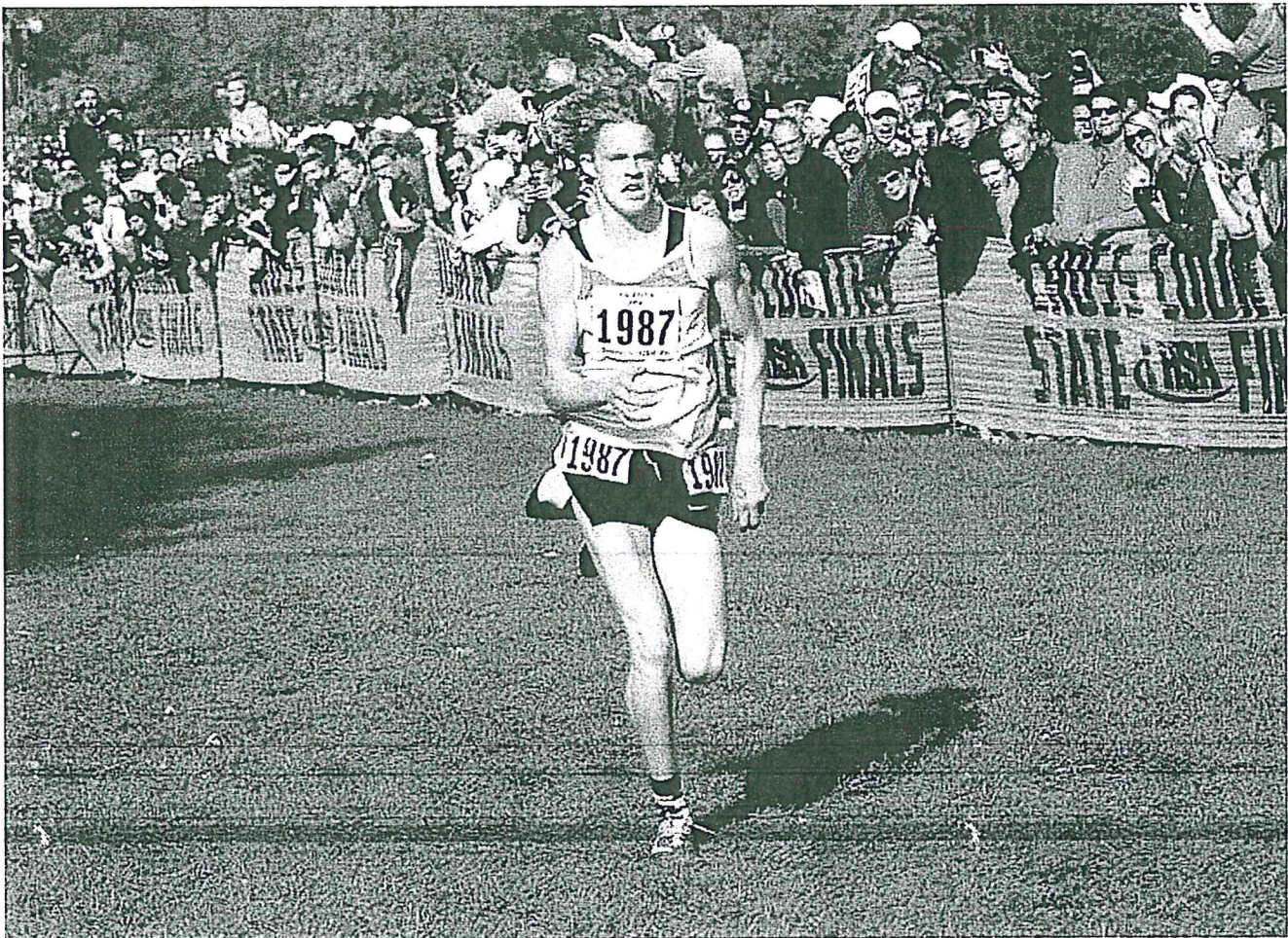

Final mile surge nets Neuqua Valley 3A Boys state championship.

Peoria – When he was younger, Soren Knudsen would borrow his dad Jim's state championship that he won back in 1981. He would wear it around the house wanting to know how it felt and looked on him. Practice makes perfect. Knudsen pulled away from the pack in the final kilometer to win in 14:02 in what was deemed one of the craziest fast paced races in recent state meet history. Soren duplicated his dad's win in 1981 when Jim ran 14:22 for the win. The two become the first father and son to win state championships in the IHSA State Cross Country Meet. It has only happened four times ever in United States high school state meets.

"It was a dream that we had. We tried not to talk about it this year," Jim said. "It was something that he wanted to do and that we wanted to share together. He is a smart kid. He has done this all himself. He has learned a lot from me over the years. He just makes great decisions."

He needed to use those decisions in this race that went off to a crazy fast start. Joey Black (O'Fallon HS) went through the first 800 in a blistering 2:08 with the pack only two seconds back. Black was in a group with Knudsen, Lake Zurich's Brian Griffith and Matt Pereira, Blake Evertsen (Hinsdale Central HS) and Dylan Jacobs (Sandburg HS) that led going through the mile in 4:35.

With 12 runners in the front of the pack, something had to give. The moves started happening at the end of the triangle portion of the course. The thing was that pace was not even slowing down.

Danny Kilrea (Lyons Township HS, LaGrange) started to push up the incline after the group passed 2 miles in 9:28. Jacobs, Knudsen, and Brian Griffith were just three seconds back. York's Charlie Kern and Lyons Township's Vince Zona were close behind trying to be in position to counter the moves.

It was Knudsen that made the definitive move as he made the left turn onto the Route 29 part of the course with a little more than a kilometer left. Knudsen passed Kilrea just before 800 to go pushing the pace even faster than before. He come up the incline knowing that Kilrea was close behind. He did not let up at all. Knudsen's time makes him the ninth fastest runner in state meet history.

"It's tough during the season. The workouts that I did before the races were super hard. The biggest thing for me was remembering what the big picture was at all times," Knudsen said. "I'm super competitive and passionate about my running. It was tough not to be at my best early in the season. It was the big races that count at the end that I was focusing on. I went through a bunch of scenarios in my head but I did not expect this one (about the pace). I was just hoping the final 1000 meters that no one had an extra gear"

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2 seconds. Kern closed the gap in the final straight away to run 14:12 to finish fourth. Lake Zurich's Brian Griffith and Matt Pereira were next finishing fifth and sixth.

It was Neuqua Valley that found an extra gear in the final mile. As the leaders were going through the first mile in 4:35, their pack was comfortable seven seconds back. At the first mile check point, their team was not even listed in the top three. They were listed at the end when it counted the most. The Wildcats, led by all state performances by Jackson Jett (8th), Zach Kinne (17th), Jake McEneaney (21st), and Matt Milostan (23rd), won the state championship with 83 points. Josh Mollway was the team's fifth runner as he finished 34th. The split on their scorers was only 23 seconds.

"The guys did exactly what we wanted them to do. Get out in position, relax, and make their move the last mile," Neuqua Valley Coach Paul Vandersteen said. "They implemented it to perfection. We did not have any race plans the last three weeks. The only thing that mattered was today. I'm convinced that we only have so much mental energy. We wanted to apply it to today's race."

Downers Grove North continued their great racing this season with a 2nd place finish and also a 23 second split on their top five. Ale C Danner led the team with a 12th place finish as well as Jacob Ridderhoff finishing 15th. Lake Zurich finished third (186 points) led by the two all-state finishes by Brian Griffith and Matt Pereira.
