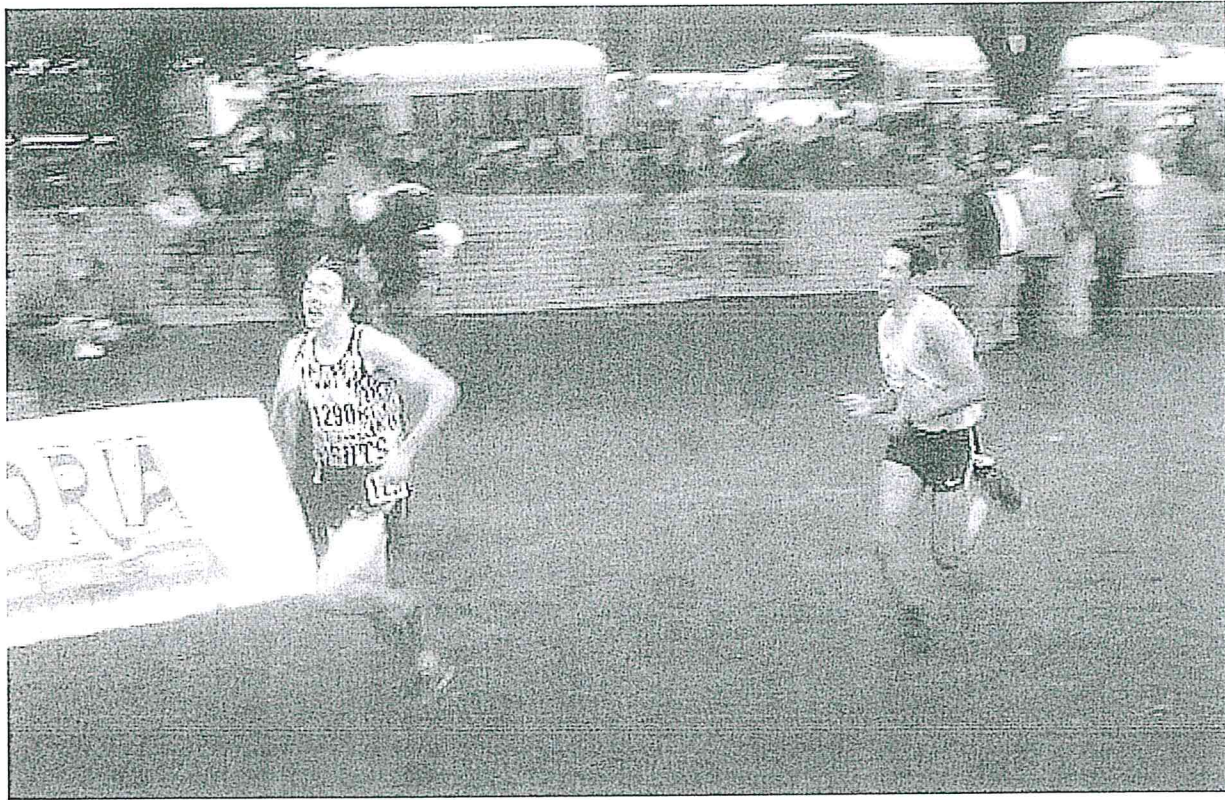




Mahomet-Seymour captures back to back 2A team championships

Peoria – The photo finish in the Kaneland Sectional race between Sterling's Jacob Gebhardt and Kaneland's Matthew Richtman was just the appetizer for what was to happen in Saturday's 2A Boys State Race. Fans always hope for the exciting finish, the close finish, or the race that a winner is not decided until the final steps of the race.

The 2A Boys race gave us all that...and more.

All eyes were supposed to be on race favorites Gebhardt, Richtman, and Crystal Lake South's Jack Becker. No one was expecting Brett Haffner of Hinsdale South in the lead. The senior made this race what it was taking the lead after the first turn and then going through the mile in 4:40. He was five seconds ahead of the pack.

"While not an intended one by any means, I took a huge risk yesterday," Haffner said on Twitter on Sunday. "It gave me invaluable experience for the future, I do not regret it." Haffner's bold move forced the pack especially after the mile to make a move. They knew that they would have to go get him that he was not coming back. Gebhardt saw that as he surged to try to close the gap.

Becker, Gebhardt, and Richtman caught and passed Haffner just before the half-way point of the race. The three pulled away from the pack with Haffner fading to ninth by two miles. The trio passed in 9:39 setting up a fast-final mile of the race.

It was a matter of who would blink first. Who would get the itch to take the advantage for the final sprint to the finish?

Richtman made the turn at the s-turn with a furious sprint hoping to gain the advantage. Gebhardt was making the effort to stay close. Becker slowly was starting to fall back but still in a full sprint.

Gebhardt pumped his arms harder getting him even with Richtman in the final 50-meters. The two were side-by-side until the final 10 steps that Richtman surged to get the win. Only seven tenths of a second separated the two with both given the same time of 14:23.

"This was better than I could have imagined. This is better because our team ran great too," Richtman said as he hugged his teammates after the finish.

"I was trying to drop them after we passed Haffner, but they just weren't dropping," Gebhardt said after the race. "I knew it was going to be that close after sectionals. We just kept pushing each other towards the finish. I felt something in my legs in the final five meters that I have never felt before."

"The last 200-meters when I finally got the lead, I just gave it everything I had," Richtman added. "We've replicated this finish at state in practice so many times. I was so scary at the end. I was hoping I would just stay one step ahead of him."

Becker ended up in third (14:31) some 14 seconds ahead of the rest of the pack.

Mahomet-Seymour had one of the most dominating 2A team performances in last year's state meet. This year's team was different. "We've had that strong group up front all year," Mahomet-Seymour Coach Neil Garrison said. "It has been our fourth and fifth runners that have not showed that confidence in some of our races. We've been coming on strong."

The Bulldogs put it all together on this state race day especially Bryson Keeble and Evan Burge who picked up valuable points for their team passing runners in the final 800-meters of the race. Their contribution, along with three all-state runners, allowed Mahomet-Seymour to win their second straight 2A state championship with 91 points. Normal University (114 points) and Sycamore (151 points) finished second and third.

Mathias Powell led the Bulldogs finishing fourth overall. Riley Fortune (6th place) and Ryan Hodge (9th place) were in the top ten giving their team great low numbers. Keeble (45th) and Burge (72nd) rounded out their scorers.

Normal University had a good race scoring 91 points with a 27 second split from their second runner Jackson McClure to fifth runner Harris Porter. They had five runners in before Mahomet's did, but it was the strength that Mahomet had up front that was the difference. Jared Shuckman had an all-state race finishing eighth overall to lead his team.

Sycamore's third-place finish with 151 points was paced by Stephen Poorten. The senior last year was injured right before state not allowing him to run. He bounced back with a great season concluding with a seventh-place finish.

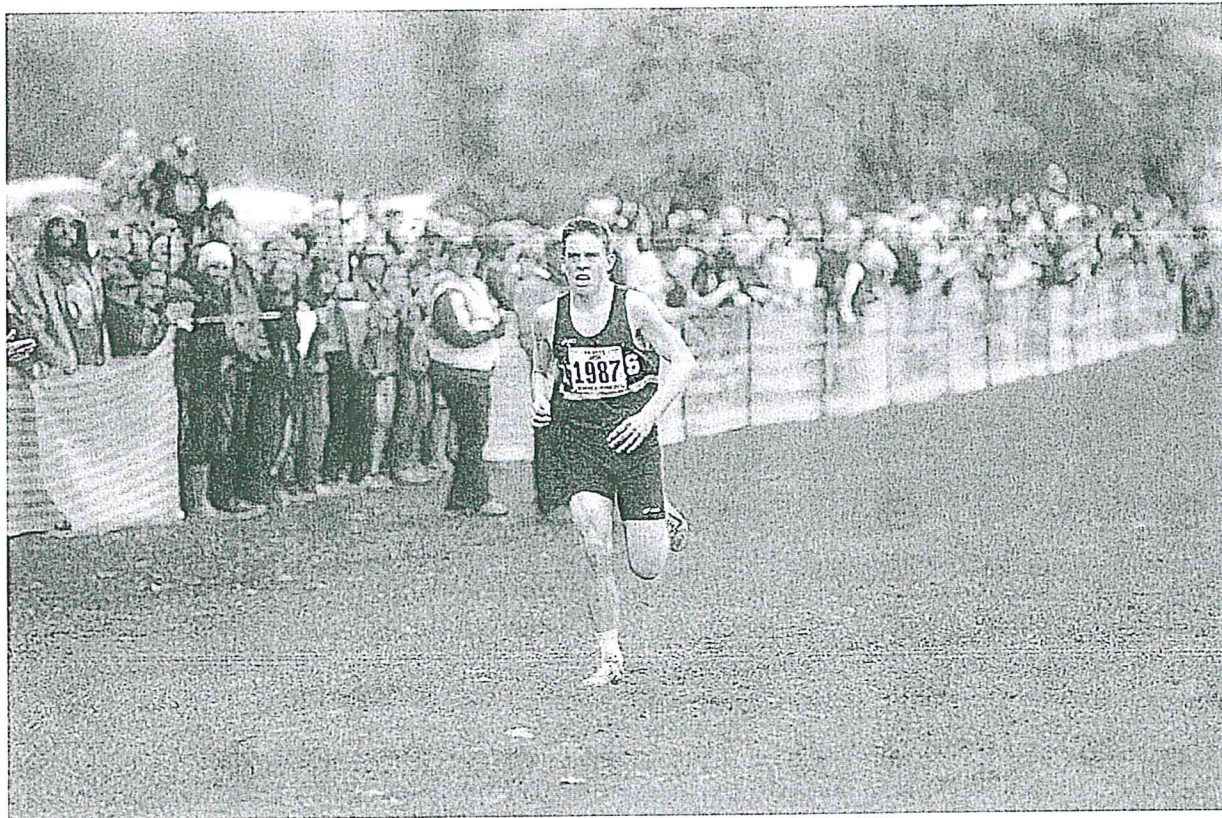

Peoria – There are times that we want things to happen and yet the circumstances around us do not cooperate. Fans came to Detweiller Park Saturday afternoon hoping to see a state record threatened. A soft course, due to rain in the area over the past week, made it slower. Nevertheless, it did not bother Lyons Township's Danny Kilrea, who controlled the race throughout to win an elusive state title.

It was supposed to be a dual between Kilrea and Sandburg's Dylan Jacobs who were the top two runners in the state all year. It did not materialize as Jacobs was still recovering from an illness that he came down with earlier in the week.

"To be honest, I did not think he would be able to run today on Wednesday," Sandburg coach John O'Malley said as Jacobs and the team ran on the course Friday afternoon. "It was just that serious. He has progressed. We will just see what he will be able to do tomorrow."

Kilrea learned his lesson the week before at the Hinsdale Central Sectional in letting Jacobs get ahead early never to recover. In this race, the two runners were together at 800 meters, slowly pulling away from the rest of the pack. By the time the two got to the first mile in 4:34, Kilrea had a close lead with Jacobs just a couple steps behind. The Sandburg senior was efforting just a little bit.

It showed as Kilrea took control of the race going through 1.5 miles in 6:55 and 9:18 at 2-miles. Whitney Young's Clayton Mendez had been patient the first mile of the race but had moved up to catch Jacobs as the two were 12 seconds behind Kilrea.

The Lyons Township senior continued to push on the final loop of the course now looking for the win with the record of 13:50.6 out of reach. The second-place finish from last year was still in his mind as he approached the finish line. That memory was erased as he crossed the line arms in the air running 14:07 for the win.

"I have been working for this moment ever since November 5, 2016. The state championship has been on my mind. It is great that my dream has finally come true," said Kilrea. "I threw time out the window. The course felt good yesterday. This morning after the rain and five races, I knew it was going to be a competition kind of race. I knew that Dylan wasn't racing like himself at the mile when he wasn't up there with me. I knew something was different today, but I just rolled with it."

Clayton Mendez finished strong to end his regular season placing second (14:22). Tommy Brady of Maine South worked his way towards the front as the race progressed giving him a third-place finish (14:29) four seconds ahead of Neuqua Valley's Zach Kinne who finished fourth. The surprise of the race was the finish of Niles North's Conor Perreault. The senior had finished eighth the week before at the Lake Park Sectional. On this day, a personal best of 14:33 and a fifth-place finish were his.

Dylan Jacobs had faded in the final mile. His heart and inner-strength pushed him the final 400-meters as he passed four runners to finish sixth overall. He refused to use being under the weather as an excuse.

"I was a little bit under the weather this week, but I still came out here with the same goals," Jacobs said. "He started pushing it at 1.5 miles. My legs really did not feel that good. You deal with it and live and learn from that situation. I was proud of how I did and how my teammates did."

Downers Grove North executed their race plan just as they had all season and it resulted with the first state team championship in the program's history. The Trojans had four all state runners along with 5 in the first 27 to capture the 3A title with 73 points.

"This feeling is unbelievable. It's incredible," Downers Grove North coach John Sipple said. "I am so proud of the kids. They ran super tough."

"We did not think of the pressure of having the target on our backs," Miles Christensen said. "It was just a three-mile race and we just had to get it done."

They did in a big way especially with the pack running that they have exhibited throughout the season. Senior Jacob Ridderhoff led team being the first runner across placing eighth and running 14:36. Then came the pack that was only separated by nine seconds between the four runners. Nick Chudzik led the group in 19th. Then it was Miles Christensen who was two seconds back in 21st with Jack Roberts just one place behind. Sam McCool just missed all-state finishing 27th overall, but his time of 14:53 makes him one of the fastest fifth runners ever. Their team time of 73:46 is the eight fastest ever for a team in the state meet tying them with Neuqua Valley's state championship team of 2007. That's impressive considering how soft the course was on this day.

"This win is a win for everyone that is supporting us. It was so awesome to see how many people came out today," Jacob Ridderhoff said. "It was so much easier to know that there was so many people that had our back out on the course including the teammates that were running and our teammates that were not running."

DuPage Valley Conference rivals, for at least this season, Neuqua Valley and Wheaton-Warrenville South finished second and third separated by only seven points. The 149 points by the Wildcats were paced by Zach Kinne's fourth-place finish and a 23 second split between their second through fifth runners. Ryan Kennedy led the pack placing 33rd followed by Danny Winek (39th), Michael Madiol (56th), and Alex Johnson (71st).

Wheaton-Warrenville South earned their first trophy in the program's history scoring 156 points in third. Sophomore William Hauenstein earned all-state honors by finishing 13th to lead his team. Sean and Scott Maisson were next finishing 32nd and 45th. Jacob Kluckhohn was the team's fourth runner by placing 47th. John Keys was the team's fifth runner as he placed 82nd. The Tigers will be the team to watch in 2018 as six of their top seven from this race return.

The next four teams that finished were all from the ultra-tough West Suburban Conference-Silver Division. This is the toughest conference in the nation considering you have five of the top seven teams in the state including the 3A team champion and the 3A individual champion. Hinsdale Central was 12 points out of a trophy placing 168 points. Lyons Township (191 points), York (206 points), and Glenbard West (223 points) followed.

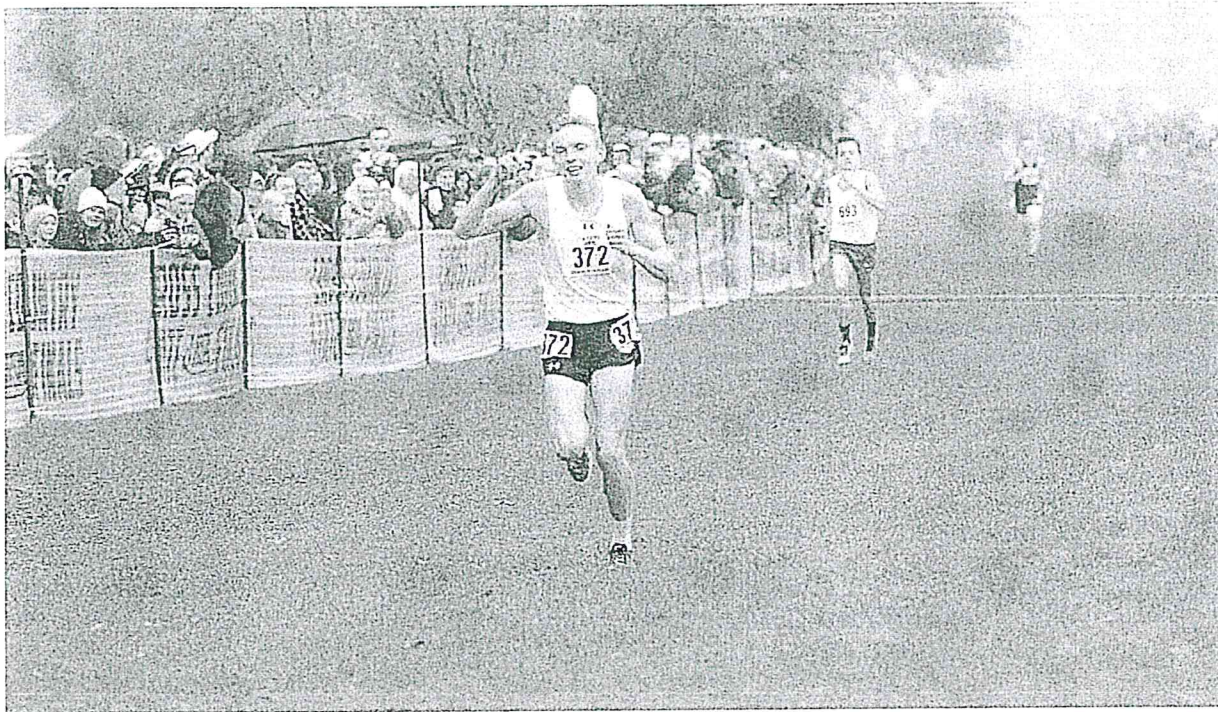

Elmwood-Brimfield wins eighth state title

Peoria – Wyatt McIntyre of Athens showed in the end that he had the final move.

The IHSA 1A Boys State meet race Saturday at Detweiller Park will go down as one of those races that we will talk about years from now. The three runners going after one title. The lead changing places so many times during the almost 15 minutes they were on the course. Detweiller Park was not in the best condition as rain hit the area hours before the meet started. It did not bother this group.

McIntyre and Logan Hall of Arthur-Lovington led a pack of near 10 runners through a 4:46 opening mile. McIntyre started to push the pace with Hall close to his side. It was the first move of the race. Jack McNabola of Francis Parker followed close behind not wanting to leave the front. The pace of this race was picking up. You could see it in the intensity of the faces of the runners behind them see the race ramped up a level and trying to stay within touch of the front.

Hall, McIntyre, and McNabola had started to gap the rest of the pack by the time they left the back half of the course "the triangle". Each runner was feeling the other out regarding pace. As they made the turn coming up to the two-mile mark, McNabola made a little move to take the lead. Then Hall passed him back. As the three passed two miles in 9:40, McIntyre made a surge coming up the incline towards the finish. There was one more loop of the course that was needed to be made.

Making the left turn around the tree going behind the starting area, McNabola went in to an all-out sprint defining his mark on this race opening a 10-meter lead. With 800-meters to go, it was Hall's turn to push the pace as he took the lead. The other two runners were not budging. They knew what was at stake.

In the Patriot Invitational on this course three weeks before state, Hall was the one to make the move at the end pulling away from McIntyre. The tables turned as the three moved through the s-turn on to the final straight away. McIntyre went into an all-out sprint with Hall and McIntyre holding on. It was McNabola who fell back first with 200-meters to go. McIntyre continued to surge up the final hill towards the finish finally created a gap ahead of his future University of Illinois teammate Hall.

McIntyre, in the final 50-meters, looked back five times to see the lead that he had. He crossed the line with his arms in the air. State champion he could proclaim.

"I thought if the first mile went out a little slow, I would have to push the second. Logan (Hall) covered that move and took the lead. I just stayed behind him," McIntyre said. "I made a move by the finish line, then Jack did. The rest of the way was tactics just waiting for that final 300-meters."

"Jack made a move with 1200-meters to go, but Wyatt and I worked together to track him back down," Hall said after the race. "I just wanted to stay with them and not do anything stupid. I knew it was going to come down to the last half-mile. It came down to the final homestretch. I just did not have anything for him."

McIntyre time of 14:25 was five seconds ahead of Hall who ran 14:30 to finish second. McNabola gave all he had in this race. He finished in third (14:40) collapsing to the ground as he crossed the finish line.

Then the pack came in led by Monticello's Alec Helmuth in fourth (15:02). Riley Wells of Rockford Christian made one of the big moves of the race. he was close to 20th place at 2-miles. He ended up finishing fifth

Elmwood-Brimfield starts out every season slow building to be in contention for a state championship every season. That happened again on Saturday as they won their first team title since 2013 and eighth in the program's history scoring 150 points finishing ahead of Rockford Christian (164 points) and 2016 team champion Harvest Christian Academy (170 points). The Trojans had two all-state runners in the top 25. Cooper Hoffmann led his team by finishing 17th overall (15:21). Four seconds later came in Trevor Dunkel placing 23rd. There was a gap of 38 seconds before the rest of the Elmwood pack came in with Luke Hoffmann (60th), Alex Hermann (66th), and Jacob Brown (93rd). The split on their top five was 66 seconds.
