LEAFS 2ND IN OWN INVITE

On Saturday, September 18th, Geneseo hosted the annual Geneseo Cross Country Invitational. The field included teams from: Geneseo, Moline, Ottawa, Pleasant Valley, Sterling, Rock Island, and United Township. The teams were treated to one of the nicest Mid-September days that we can remember. Race-time temperatures were in the 60's with a moderate dew point. The wind was non-existent. Add to all this the fact that the course was hard and fast due to the extended drought and the end result was optimal racing conditions. A slight rain fell the night before to help knock down any crop dust that was present due to the current corn harvest that is underway.

The Geneseo Cross Country Invitational has NOT been held since 2018. The meet was not held in 2019 due to weather conditions that made the course unrunable. Over a foot of standing water rested on the lower portion of the course. Last year's invitational was cancelled due to COVID-19. Thankfully, this year was a go. We did lose several teams that had competed in past years. Hopefully, they will return in the coming years. The format for the Invite is unique. The idea came from Coach Dick Kloepper from Crystal Lake. There is a scored race for each grade level. Medals are awarded to the Top 20 finishers in each grade and gender (the girls ran also.) In addition, team awards go to the winning team in each "Class Race". Then, the team points are added up for each grade to come up with an Overall Boys and Girls Combined Team Champion. Then, those totals are added to obtain the Overall Combined Champion Team. Head Maple Leaf

XC Coach Todd Ehlert "tweaked" the format when he took over by combining the Freshman and Sophomore races and the Junior and Senior races. The end result is the meet takes half as long and the coaches and athletes seem to like this change. The temperatures in Mid-September can get very warm so this avoids that challenge. In addition, park district soccer games are no longer a conflict since the meet is over before they start. Well done, Coach Ehlert. Add in the fact that the race is "Chipped" by the Shazam Race Crew who also laid down mile split pads at both the mile- and two-mile marks to record mile splits which is the reason most of the coaches were "High Fiving" each other.

On to the races. I will report on each of the four boys races. The Freshman Boys (and Girls) Race started along with the Sophomore Boys (and Girls) at 9:00 a.m. sharp. (I will report on each race separately.) The Geneseo Freshmen were led by Dylan Gehl who rolled to 2nd place overall with a time of 17:54. That is pretty amazing considering that Dylan was home sick for several days earlier in the week. The "Dude" is a "Gamer". Dylan's time was the 2nd fastest time by a Freshman on the current Richmond Hill 3-mile course EVER and saw him run the 6th fastest time on the day by a Geneseo Runner (only 3 seconds from 3rd.) Way to Roll, Dylan. Also grabbing hardware (Medals to the Top 20) were: Max Johnson (12th Place in 20:18); Rylan Lambert (13th Place in 20:19); Christian Haney (16th Place in 20:36); and Taber Swanson (20th Place in 21:20.) Not far behind were Mason Anderson (23rd Place in 22:48) and Zach Meier (30th Place in 25:39.) When the points were totaled, the Leafs found themselves in 2nd place in the team competition behind a powerful Pleasant Valley Squad. Amazingly, six of the seven men ran lifetime bests for 3 miles. The fact that this occurred on our challenging Richmond Hill course is quite impressive. Camden Baumgardner, Jacob Taylor, and Dylan Whipple were unavailable due to medical reasons. The future looks incredibly bright for this group of young men. There is a plethora of talent in this group and it is going to be a lot of fun to watch them improve over the remainder of this season and beyond. "Dream Big", Men and then back it up with the work that excellence demands.

The Sophomore Squad ran to a solid 4th place team finish in the day's deepest field which included 38 runners. "Nailing" "Top 20 Medals" were Cooper Schaad (3rd Place in 17:51) and Sam Mosbarger (10th Place in 18:25.) Cooper ended up as Geneseo's 3rd fastest man on the day while Sam was the 7th. Way to compete, Men. Not far behind were: Austin Hull (26th Place in 21:07); Ryley Rowold (31st Place in 22:50 which was a Lifetime Best); and Bryce Henderson (36th Place in 27:07.) The Geneseo Sophomore Class only numbers five but contains a group of young men that we are very excited about. Two members of this group have already grabbed Top 7 Positions on the VARSITY Team with the other three also possessing a lot of potential. Success in distance running often goes to those that "Stay the Course" and "Pay the Price" that Excellence Demands. Keep Dreaming Big, Men. Optimism runs deep in the "Land of the Leafs".

The Juniors and Seniors took off at 9:45 a.m. In the Junior Race, the Leafs were competing with only three runners and had to count two "Ghost Runners". A "Ghost Runner" position occurs if a team doesn't have a complete scoring five runners (or more.) Most of the teams had "Ghost Runners" calculated into one or more of the races. Since there were 26 runners who competed in the Junior Division we had 27 and 28 added to our team score. Despite that occurring, the Leafs still managed to place a Remarkable 2nd Place in the Team Competition. Leading the race was

was Gavin Allison who broke the Geneseo Junior Class Record for the Richmond Hill 3-mile course (number 2 time for anyone.) Gavin "Stopped the Clock" at 16:50 (good for 2nd place). Not far behind were Tyler Gehl (6th Place in 17:53) and Nathan Venneberg (19th Place in 22:02.) All three men earned a highly coveted "Top 20" finisher medal. Caleb Durian and Karson Emry were unable to compete due to medical issues. The Geneseo Junior Class isn't large but possesses a plethora of talent that has the coaching staff "drooling". Keep an eye on these men...they are going to make some MAJOR NOISE. Two of them have already grabbed "Top 5" VARSITY positions. Gavin has run as the team's number one man in every race except one. Way to roll, Men. Keep up the great work.

It is appropriate that the the last race to be examined is the Senior Boys Race. After all, it was SENIOR DAY. The Maple Leafs put forth a ferocious effort and fell just two points shy of a very powerful and State-Ranked Pleasant Valley Spartan Squad. P.V. beat the Leafs 50-52. The Leafs were led by Justin Johnson who placed 2nd in the race and destroyed the Geneseo School Record by 15 seconds which had been set by William Plumley. Justin's time was 16:44. Not far behind him and also winning "Top 20" Finisher Medals were: Isaac Kuster (6th Place in 17:52); Carson Raya (11th Place in 18:59); Malakai Schaad (13th Place in 19:01); and Simon Anderson (20th Place in 21:41.) The Leafs final finisher was Andrew Burke who sprinted home in 22nd Place and "Stopped the Clock" at 21:49. Andrew barely missed a medal. The effort that the Senior Class put forth was simply AWESOME. This is a VERY Special Team. The Seniors were honored with Individual Senior Posters (of them) and a group shot that was placed on posters that they autographed. It was a "FAST AND FURIOUS" kind of day. Thank you Seniors for all that you have and will give this team. All the best in the coming weeks as YOUR team starts to close in on "Championship Meet Season". Keep Dreaming BIG. This team is positioned to make some major NOISE during the remainder of the season. God Bless each and every one of you.

By the way, when all the grade level points were added together, the Leafs had placed 2nd to Pleasant Valley in the Overall Boys Combined Competition. Then, when those points were added to the Overall Girls Combined Scores, the Leafs placed 2nd to the Pleasant Valley Spartans. Well Done, Leafs. All the best at the Sterling Rock River Run Invitational next Saturday.

Spartans dominate team standings of meet's unique setup

GENESEO — Taking place for the first time since 2018, the Geneseo cross country invitational returned with a unique format.

In order to finish ahead of the warmest of Saturday's weather, the boys' and girls' runners raced together and were grouped by class, starting with the freshmen and finishing with the seniors.

That afforded multiple runners from the competing teams the opportunity to strike gold, and a pair of competitors from Moline and United Township did just that at Richmond Hill Park.

In the two senior-class races, the Panthers' duo of Logan Veloz and Maddie Miller completed their three-mile runs at the head of

their respective packs, with Miller's time of 19:17.9 putting her well ahead of runner-up Abby DeBlieck of Moline (20:51.0).

"I just went into the race wanting to go out big," Miller said. "We had a hard pack, and the hills were tough, so I knew what was coming and prepared myself. That helped me going in, and my performance was good."

Saturday's win gives Miller four wins in the five invitationals UT has competed at this fall, with the exception being a 17th-place showing at Peoria's First to the Finish Invite.

"With this being my senior year, my goal this year is to make it all the way to state," she said. "It's good to get focused on that early."

Fellow Panther senior Veloz, meantime, had a much closer finish as his winning time of 16:41.4 edged Geneseo's Justin Johnson by a little over three seconds.

"It's always the plan to win, but coming here, I wasn't sure if

I could win or not," he said. "It's a hard course, and I figured (Johnson) would be there with me. He definitely pushed me to the limit; it wasn't an easy win."

For Veloz, Saturday's win was his first invitational title of the season. Now, he is hoping for more.

"It's good, but I definitely can do better," he said. "I hope it goes up from here. I want to come back and see if I can win more."

Among the younger classes, the Moline girls' harriers scored individual victories in the freshman and sophomore competitions.

The Maroons' Alexis Havercamp took the sophomore win with a time of 20:42.6, while teammate Lily Jorgenson was the freshman winner with a 21:37.2 clocking.

"I ran here last year in middle school (with the John Deere team)," said Havercamp. "I like hilly courses, and I was just a couple of seconds short of my P.R."

"I just wanted to shave my time and try my best," Jorgenson added. "I'm just excited that we get to have a good season this year."

PV dominates as a team: Running as a split squad with its other athletes in action at Saturday's Heartland Classic in Pella, Iowa, the Pleasant Valley Spartans still won seven of the eight races as it captured the cumulative team title.

PV also crowned a pair of individual champions. In the junior boys' race, Jacob Mumey hit the tape in 16:23.1 to finish nearly a half-minute up on the Maple Leafs' Gavin Allison.

"I came in knowing it was going to be a tough course, with all the ups and downs," said Mumey. "My goal was to make myself feel comfortable, and get the win. It definitely could've been better, so the only way to go is up."

Freshman teammate Cameron Gotto struck gold in his race with a 17:13.8 clocking. Like Mumey, he

topped a Geneseo runner — Dylan Gehl (17:54.7) — to take the title.

"I think my approach was relatively the same, to get out ahead and stay with the fast pack," Gotto said, referring to running in a larger group with both boys' and girls' runners. "I had my eyes on who to look out for, and I stuck with them."

Solid day for Leafs: As for meet host Geneseo, it enjoyed a solid day with second-place team showings in six of the eight races.

In the senior boys' competition, the Leafs came close to joining junior girls' team winner Ottawa as the other non-PV champion. Geneseo tallied 52 points to finish just two behind the Spartan seniors.

"We had a great day," said Geneseo boys' coach Todd Ehlert. "We're still getting into shape, but most of our guys ran their best race at this course, and my seniors really ran well."
