LEAFS GRAB FINAL TEAM SPOT TO QUALIFY FOR STATE

On Saturday, October 30th, the Leafs traveled to Metamora's Black Partridge Park to participate in their assigned IHSA Sectional Meet. The field included teams from: Bartonvile (Limestone), Bloomington, Calumet City (Thornton Fractional North), Chicago Heights (Mariam), Dunlap, East Peoria, Geneseo, Harvey (Thornton), LaSalle-Peru, Lemont, Metamora, Midlothian (Bremen), Morton, Morris, Normal Community (West), Oak Forest, Peoria (Notre Dame), and Washington. The meet was scheduled to start at 11:00 a.m with the Girls race to be followed at 12:00 p.m. by the Boys race. Due to HEAVY RAINS (4-7 inches depending who you ask) over the last two days. The course was SOAKED and a true "MUD-FEST". The race times were moved back four hours so the boys raced at 4:00 p.m. following the girls race which was at 3:00 p.m. The conditions were "Special" and will probably never be forgotten by anyone in attendance. Since I can't run anymore I was on my bike and my rims sank all the way in multiple times. It was AWESOME to watch the guys race in such conditions. The race-time temperature was 55° with an 11 mph wind from the Northwest.

Last year, the IHSA Advisory Committee suggested that there be some changes. They suggested reducing the number of Regional meets that "feed" each Sectional from four to three. They also suggested reducing the number of Sectionals from Five to Four. The "goal" of the committee was to get MORE teams to the State Meet and Raise the Bar in regard to the quality of the teams that qualify. Mission accomplished. The new system advances the top 6 teams from each Regional instead of 5. Then, at the Sectional level, the Top 7 teams now advance instead of the traditional 5. The end result will be 28 teams competing in both the 2A and 3A State Finals. 1A uses a different system. In addition to the Top 7 teams advancing from Sectional to State the Top 10 Individual Runners NOT on advancing Teams will also advance. That number was raised from 7 to 10. Since there was no "Official" State Meet last year, this will be the first time that this new system will be in action. I like what I've seen so far. It is still HARD to qualify but the changes were an improvement.

Thus, on the line were seven tickets to next Saturday's IHSA STATE FINALS. In addition, the top 10 individuals who were NOT on the 7 advancing teams also would qualify as Individuals and advance to the State Finals to be held at Peoria's "Historic" Detweiller Park. In regard to "premeet" calculations and predictions, the Leafs were "Ranked" 6th by Athletic.Net and 7th by Michael Newman's ILXCTF website. Both are estimates and with all the "Muck" it was anybody's guess who would qualify. It was also a pretty safe bet to state that there were a LOT of future "All-Staters" in the field. This Sectional meets all the requirements to be considered "Elite".

On to the racing. The "Muck" was "Flyin" early and often once the starter's pistol "Cracked" at 4:00 p.m. The field attacked the slippery course knowing what was riding on this race. In many ways the Sectional Meet is more "Nerve Wrecking" than the actual State Meet itself. The Leafs were led by Junior Gavin Allison who cracked the Top 20 with his 19th place finish. Gavin was timed in 16:24 for the 2.94 mile course. Gavin's time just missed his personal best for the course but does rank as the 14th Fastest Time EVER for a Geneseo Runner on the Black Partridege Park Course. Next up was Senior Justin Johnson who sprinted home in 30th place with a time of 16:40. Justin, also just missed his personal best on the course but his Sectional Time was the 20th Fastest Time EVER for a Geneseo Runner on the Course. What happened next was simply inspiring. The next five men ran their FASTEST time EVER at Metamora's Black Partridge Park IN THE MUCK. How is that even possible? All five men finished within twelve seconds of each other. Leading "da Pack" was Sophomore Sam Mosbarger who sprinted home in 17:05 for 51st place. His time was the 9th fastest time for a Sophomore on the course in School History. Also timed in 17:05 and sprinted home in 53rd place was Junior Tyler Gehl. Tyler's time was the 10th fastest time for a Junior on the Course In School History. One second back was Freshman Dylan Gehl who clocked 17:06 and placed 55th overall. His time was the 5th fastest time for a Geneseo Freshman EVER at Black Partridge Park. Next up was Senior Isaac Kuster. Isaac sprinted across the finish line in 17:10 and placed 59th overall. Isaac ran as the Leafs' number three man for much of the race and really helped to inspire his teammates. Isaac's time was the 9th Fastest Time for a Senior EVER on the Course. Sophomore Cooper Schaad was up next and clocked 17:17 and placed 62nd overall. His time was the 13th Fastest Time EVER for a Sophomore on the Course.

After the race, we tried to find each man and tell them, "GREAT JOB!". I was pretty certain the team had qualified but when I found Head Maple Leaf Coach Todd Ehlert, he had a worried look

on his face. He told me that we were between 7th and 10th. I thought we might have finished in the Top 5. I have always had a hard time calculating the finishing order while the races are being run. I just get too fired up. Anyway, Coach Ehlert's comment made me nervous. Qualifying for the STATE FINALS IS A HARD THING TO DO. We had to wait for quite a while for the "Unofficial Results" to be posted. Coach Ehlert sprinted over to the pavilion where they were posted and started to jump up and down (That is a GOOD thing). The team had grabbed the last qualifying position as they placed 7th overall. It was awesome to watch the team celebrate together. There were some memories made in the moment that will stay with me for the rest of my life. GREAT JOB, MEN!
