LEAFS DOMINATE ANNAWAN-WETHERSFIELD TITAN XC INVITE

On Monday, August 30th, the Leafs traveled to Kewanee to participate in the Annawan-Wethersfield Titan Cross Country Invitational. The meet was hosted at the Kewanee Dunes Golf Course. The 14-team field included teams from: Annawan-Wethersfield, Cambridge, Galesburg, Galva, Geneseo, Mercer County, Monmouth-Roseville, Orion, Princeville, Ridegwood, Rockridge, ROWVA, Sherrard, and Stark County. The girls raced at 4:00 p.m. with the boys following at 4:45 p.m. The weather during the last 7 days has been brutally hot and humid. The "Dog Days of Summer" lived up to their nickname with heat indices over 100 degrees several of those days. The team was forced to practice in the evening to avoid the heat. Thus, when the weatherman gave everyone a welcomed daytime high of 86° with a low dew point in the 50's, the thumbs were definitely up. Add in wind conditions that were barely noticeable at 3 m.p.h. with a dry course and the end result was optimal racing conditions for August.

The boys race started at 4:45 p.m. The Maple Leaf duo of Junior Gavin Allison and Senior Justin Johnson really took it out hard, following the "Crack" of the starter's pistol. They were still running 1-2 when they rolled past the mile in 5:20ish. It was pretty dang exciting to see two Maple Leafs running 1-2 for most of the race. Gavin was able to hold off a fast-closing Derek Coulter from Mercer County by one second. Gavin's time of 17:06 was the fastest time ever turned in for a Geneseo runner on this course. He was closely followed into the finish chute by Justin who "stopped the clock" at 17:13 for 3rd place. Rounding out the Leafs "Top 5" were: Senior Isaac Kuster (4th Place in 18:14), Freshman Dylan Gehl (6th Place in 18:21), and Junior Tyler Gehl (8th Place in 18:26.) In case you are counting, that is five Maple Leafs in the Top 8. That is

some serious front running. Way to roll, Men. Rounding out the Leafs' Top 7 were "Super-Sop's" Cooper Schaad (12th Place in 18:52), and Sam Mosbarger (15th Place in 19:14.) Medals were awarded to the Top 20 finishers and Seniors Malakai Schaad (19th Place in 19:27), and Carson Raya (20th Place in 19:30) joined in the fun. That's right, the Leafs put NINE runners in the first 20 finishers to dominate the race and demonstrate impressive depth.

Not far behind were Junior Caleb Durian (31st Place in 20:59); Freshman Max Johnson (36th Place in 21:30); Freshman Christian Haney (37th Place in 21:36); Sophomore Austin Hull (43rd Place in 21:53); and Freshman Rylan Lambert (48th Place in 21:59) to complete the Leafs Top 14 Runners. That is the number of athletes that the Illinois High School Association will allow to be on the IHSA "Championship Meet Season" Roster. That is a "Big Deal" so well done, Men. Half of that current Top 14 is comprised of freshmen and sophomores. That is AMAZING! Up next were fast-closing Junior Nathan Venneberg (53rd Place in 22:32); Freshman Taber Swanson (57th Place in 22:55); Senior Andrew Burke (60th Place in 23:35); Freshman Dylan Whipple (62nd Place in 24:17); Freshman Mason Anderson (25:36); Freshman Jacob Taylor (70th Place in 26:04); Junior Karson Emry (72nd Place in 27:04); Sophomore Ryley Rowold (81st Place in 29:02); and Freshman Camden Baumgardner (83rd Place in 30:09.) Unable to race were: Senior Simon Anderson (Conflict); Sophomore Bryce Henderson (Conflict); and Freshman Zach Meier ((Ilness.) The Leafs will next be in action on Saturday September 4th when they travel to Galesburg's Lake Storey Park to participate in the "Silver Streak" Cross Country Invite.

This was the first "Real Meet" for the team and were are extremely impressed with the results. This team has a plethora of potential. It is going to be a lot of fun to watch each of you improve during the course of the season. "Keep Dreaming Big" in the words of Head Maple Leaf XC Coach Todd Ehlert. In addition, be sure to do everything that you can do to make that "Dream" come to fruition.
