

Geneseo girls win title; boys 2nd

Overall strength is key for girls

Geneseo's overall strength was the key as the Maple Leafs edged Quincy on a sixth-runner tiebreaker in Thursday's Western Big 6 girls cross country meet at Lake Storey Park in Galesburg.

Thanks to freshman Alivia Brown's 25th-place finish, the Maple Leafs won the tiebreaker as Quincy's sixth runner placed 28th, over 15 seconds behind Brown.

Quincy freshman Peyton Kuhl won the individual title in 18 minutes, 41.30 seconds. Teammate Amick McClelland followed runner-up Brooklyn Smith (18:55.08) of Geneseo across the finish line in third place. United Township's Rubi

Tapia-Macias (19:15.56) and Sterling's Jaz'Mya Castaneda (19:38.35) rounded out the top five.

With Quincy and Geneseo each

all had top-10 finishes.

Lindsey Britton led Alleman with a 17th-place finish (21:14.83), while Izabel Vega (21:36.93) led a four-runner contingent from Rock Island that packed in in 20th, 21st, 22nd and 23rd, all within 6.5 seconds of each other.

placing all their scorers in the top 20, placement of those top runners was key.


Lucille Wachtel (20:03.41) placed sixth as Evelyn DeBaene (11th) and Jeslen Rink (12th) also placed ahead of a Quincy trio, who placed 14th, 15th and 16th.

That left the score 31-49, meaning Geneseo needed its No. 5 runner to finish 18th to forge the tie or better to ensure the win. Sophomore Ayla Schultz gave the Maple Leafs what they needed, placing 18th in 21:24.10.

Moline finished third in the

team standings with 67 points ahead of Sterling (106), Rock Island (112), UTHS (140) and Alleman (180).

Moline's trio of Lyllian Jorgenson (7th, 20:16.18), Karen Martinez Hernandez (8th, 20:20.37) and Ellis Schilb (10th, 20:32.49)

Maple Leafs' Gehl wins boys race

Geneseo's Dylan Gehl won the individual title, but Quincy's five scoring runners all finished between fifth and ninth places Thursday to lead the Blue Devils past the Maple Leafs 35-55 for the Western Big 6 Conference boys cross country title.

Gehl, the conference runner-up as a junior, ran the 3-mile Lake Storey course in Galesburg in 15 minutes, 35.85 seconds to finish 2 1/2 seconds faster than Rock Island's Elliot Batz (15:38.42). The Rocks' Gabe Mahn (15:44.79) placed third. followed by Geneseo's Jaxson Sottos (16:17.23) and Quincy's



Eli Pope (16:29.23), who led the string of five Blue Devils across the finish line.

United Township's Malik Gbadamassi rounded out the top 10 with a time of 16:42.20. The Panthers finished fifth in the team standings with 116 points, one behind Sterling.

Harry VanVooren led sixth-place Moline with an 18th-place individual finish in 17:15.44. while Alleman (199) was eighth, led by Cristiano Saucedo (26th in

17:32.50).

LEAFS CLAIM WB-6 TEAM SILVER


On Thursday, October 17th, the Leafs traveled to Galesburg's Lake Storey Park to participate in this year's Western Big 6 Conference Cross Country Championship. The Leafs entered the meet as the defending champions. The field included teams from: Galesburg, Geneseo, Moline, Quincy, Rock Island, Rock Island (Alleman), Sterling, & United Township. The weatherman provided great conditions in regards to the temperature with a daytime high of 65°. There was a steady south wind blowing at 13 mph out of the south. Gusts were around 20 mph. The course was hard and fast.

The WB-6 chooses to run only one girls race followed by one boys. In the previous conferences that Geneseo has been a part of there were always lower level competition with the Varsity Race limited to the Top 7 only. This is our 7th year in the Western Big 6 and I have come to love the one race concept. It allows head-to-head racing. None of the programs have huge numbers so it works.

Racing started at 4:30 p.m. sharp with the girls race. The Lady Leafs and the Quincy Blue Devils each had tremendous races. Both teams are strong and when the points were totaled the teams were tied. They "broke" the tie by checking to see which school's 6th runner finished higher. The Lady Leafs ended up winning as their 6th runner finished 2 places ahead of Quicny's. Great Job, Lady Leafs. What an exciting way to start the racing.

On to the Boys Race. The Starter's pistol "Clicked" at 5:10 p.m. sharp. Coming into the meet, Quincy was projected by athletic.net to win scoring 43 points. Sterling was projected to place 2nd and score 66 points. Unfortunately, for Sterling, their top 3 runners didn't race (1 Stress Fracture, 1 Case of Mono, and 1 other). The Leafs were projected to place 3rd scoring 76 points. Rock Island was projected to place 4th with 111 points and we knew it was dangerous.

Rock Island's Junior Gabe Mahn and Sophomore Elliot Batz immediately took the lead and the Leafs' "Dynamic Duo" of Senior Dylan Gehl and Junior Jaxson Sottos settled in behind them and the race was on. Jaxson was dropped with a strong surge a bit before the 2 mile mark. Dylan just "sat" until around 600 meters to go when the Lady Leafs' Head Coach Aaron Skopek screamed at him "IT'S TIME TO GO". Dylan immediately surged away and became Geneseo's very only WB-6 XC Conference Individual Champion. Dylan was timed in a new GHS record of 15:35 for the course. Jaxson's time of 16:17 was just off his personal best for the course (set at the Galesburg Silverstreak Inv. earlier in the season.....16:07 which ranks him #2 AT). His aggressive racing caught up with him but he ran an brave race and held on to 4th pace. By the way, the Top 10 finishers earn First Team All-Conference Honors. What a great start for the Maple Leafs.

However, Quincy had plans of their own. They sat back and ran as a pack. They moved together and ended up 5-6-7-8-9 to score a mere 35 points to win the team title going away. Three of their Top 5 are Freshmen. Next year's WB-6 meet will be hosted by Geneseo at Richmond Hill Park. Let's just say we are already getting excited about that (Sectional Meet too).

Back to this year's meet. Junior Graysen Carlson was the next Leaf to "Break the Tape". He was timed in a season best time of 17:03 which was good for 14th overall. Graysen's time moved him into the number 9 spot on the GHS Junior Top 25 list for the course. Joining Graysen on the 2nd Team WB-6 All-Conference Squad (11th-20th places) were Freshman Henley Bourne (17th place timed in 17:14) and Junior Aidan Bries (19th place timed in 17:15). Both men ran season best times with Henley climbing to 2nd on the GHS Freshman list for the course. Aidan moved into to the 11th fastest Junior time EVER for a GHS Runner. Great Racing, Men.

Rounding out the Leafs' "Top 7" were Sophomore Jack Kreiss (30th place timed in 17:43) and Junior Kaden Elmer (32nd place timed in 17:50). Jack's time moved him into the number 8 Sophomore spot for a GHS Runner EVER on the course. Kaden didn't record a personal best for the course after going out Hard, trying to hang with the Quincy pack. Gutsy stuff, Kaden. He already owns the 12th fastest Junior time on the course for a GHS runner.

Cracking the Maple Leafs' "Top 10" were Senior Max Johnson (40th place timed in 18:17), Freshman Greyson Claerhout (50th place timed in 18:36.....New number 11 on the GHS Freshman List), and Senior Rylan Lambert (56th place timed in 18:46.....New #21 Senior for a GHS Runner on the Course). Great Efforts, Men. Max had a tough day (it happens) and already owns the GHS #8 time for the course with his 16:45. Bring on Regionals!!!

The next five Maple Leafs also added their names to the Lake Storey Top 25 Lists. Senior Jacob Taylor (61st place timed in 19:00......Season Best Time and new GHS #22 Senior Time for the course), Freshman Kael McCord (68th place timed in 19:11....new #15 time for a GHS Freshman EVER on the course), Freshman Fritz Bolme (70th place timed in 19:13.....Lifetime Best time for him and New #16 time for a GHS Freshman on the Lake Storey Course), Sophomore Alex Aleman (71st place timed in a Lifetime best of 19:14......new #24 Sophomore Time EVER for a GHS Runner on the Course), and Junior Calvin Bell (76th place time in a Lifetime best of 19:28.....new #23 Junior Time for a GHS Runner on the Lake Storey Course). GREAT JOB, MEN!!!

Leading the next group of Maple Leafs who all "Cracked" the Top 100 were Sophomore Micah Johnson 77th place timed in 19:33), Senior Connor Douglas (78th place timed in a personal best of 19:37), Senior Christian Haney (85th place timed in 19:43), Senior Tyler Holtzen (89th place timed in a personal best of 19:50), and Sophomore Connor Runty (93rd place timed in a personal best of 20:04).

Closing out the team's efforts were Senior Shane Bagby (112th place time in a lifetime best of 21:11), Freshman Patrick Versluis (114th place timed in a personal best time of 21:29, Sophomore Jacob Berry (115th place timed in a Season best of 21:29), Freshman Rylan Carlson (116th place timed in a Lifetime best of 21:32), Srnior Mason Anderson (122nd place timed in a season best of 22:26), and Senior Camden Baumgardner (132nd place timed in 23:20). Great Efforts, Men.

Once the "Dust had Settled", the Leafs had placed a strong 2nd scoring 55 points. The Lake Storey course is longer than the 3.00 they claim. It is at least 3.05. It is also has a plethora of turns and rolling hills that make it a challenging course. That's a good thing. It is a true XC course. However, it is simply "Jaw-Dropping" that this team STILL had 14 Personal Bests EVER for ANY Course. It was also VERY windy and 18 guys still ran their fastest time EVER on the course. GREAT STUFF, MEN. We are VERY proud of all of you.

For those of you racing for the final time at Sterling on Tuesday, all the best. Try and make it your greatest race of the season. To those of you who will be racing in Dunlap on Saturday, October 16th, all the best then. The team's goal has been to be racing at Detweiller in November (STATE MEET) all season long. Each of you can help the team to accomplish that goal in some way. Do your best to accomplish that goal. God Bless ALL of you.
