


"SUPER-SOPHS" LEAD LEAFS

LEAFS ROLL IN 49th GENE JONES METAMORA "RUNNIN RED" CROSS COUNTRY INVITATIONAL

On Saturday, October 11th, the Leafs traveled to Metamora's Black Partridge Park to participate in the 49th Gene Jones Runnin' Red Cross Country Invitational. The meet is the final regular season meet before the team enters "Championship Meet Season". The Leafs will host the Western Big Six Conference Championship on Thursday, October 16th. The Maple Leafs have had a busy week



that included homecoming activities. They also had their last heavy week of training. They entered the meet a bit tired but ready for the challenge.

The 30-team field included teams from: Bloomington, Canton, Deer Creek / Mackinaw, Dunlap, East Peoria, Eureka, Geneseo, Glenbard South, Lincoln, Macomb, Mahomet-Seymour, Metamora, Moline, Morton, Normal Community, Normal (U-High), Ottawa, Oswego (East), Peoria (Christian), Peoria (Notre Dame), Peoria (Richwoods), Pekin, Rantoul, Rochester, Rock Island, Springfield, Springfield (Lincoln), Springfield (Sacred Heart Griffin), Tolono (Unity), & Washington. Numerous teams were ranked high in the Illinois Running News State Rankings.

The teams were treated to near perfect racing conditions. The dew point was in the 20's and the race time temperatures were in the low 60's. The course was hard and fast. Team trophies were awarded to the Top 3 teams and Individual Medals went to the Top 30 Finishers. No easy feat in this field.

Before I get to the races I would like to share a little bit about the man this meet is named after. Gene Jones. He started this Invite 49 years ago.

HALL OF FAME COACH GENE JONES

For 52 years, Gene Jones prowled Illinois cross country courses at Metamora High School, leading the Redbirds to state prominence and inspiring generations of students to set goals, push themselves and have a great time doing it. His boys teams won 32 conference titles, eight regionals, four sectionals and made 16 state-meet appearances, finishing in the Top 10 eight times. Eighteen boys earned All-State honors, including 1987 champion Mark Scheirer. Jones started the girls program in 1976 and won 19 conference titles, 13 regionals, three sectionals and qualified for 14 state meets. He coached 12 All-State girls. Combined, Jones's teams posted a dual-meet record of 697-144. He was named the Illinois Coach of the Year for girls in 2005 and for the boys in 2013, and he was one of eight finalists for National Coach of the Year in 2006. He is both a colleague and a friend. It was awesome to see him honored this way. He deserved it. He is still "In the Game" working as an IHSA Official. He was at the meet.

On to the racing. The F/S Boys "Toed d Line" first. Their race started at 10:00 a.m. sharp. The Leafs continued their tradition of racing all of the freshmen and sophomores in this race. Sophomore Henley Bourne has been the Leafs' number one man for much of the season and raced with a plethora of confidence. He was amongst the leaders the entire race until he "Dropped the Hammer" and spurted away for the win. He was timed in a quick 15:50 which is the 6th fastest time for a GHS runner of any grade EVER on the course. He moved into the number 3 Sophomore position. Great Stuff, Henley. All the best in "Championship Meet Season. He is on a roll and will be a force to be dealt with.

Not far behind him was fellow Sophomore Greyson Claerhout who ran a tremendous race himself. Greyson ended up placing 7th overall and was timed in 16:33 (4th fastest Leaf on the day). His time is the 18th fastest time ever for a Maple Leaf on the course and 7th best time for a GHS Sophomore. That was over a minute off his best time on the course from last year. Greyson has "Been on Fire" and really gives the Maple Leafs a plethora of depth. All the best in

"Championship Meet Season". Keep "Dreaming Big" and don't listen to the "Little Man". Both Greyson and Henley earned Top 30 Individual Finisher Medals. Great Job, Men.

Next up for the Leafs was Sophomore Kael McCord who just missed an individual medal. He ended up placing 34th and was timed in 17:30. That time moved him into 24th on the GHS Sophomore Top 25 list for the course. Great Job, Kael. The field was HUGE and he was on his own with no teammates to work with. That won't be the case in the next couple of meets, with smaller fields and his Junior and Senior teammates will be in the same race (only 1 race). All the best, Kael. The team is really on a roll and so are you. Keep racing with confidence and pride.

Sophomores Fritz Bolme and Rylan Carlson finished as the Maple Leafs' 4th and 5th men and helped lead the team to a tremendous 5th place team finish. They placed 70th and 76th overall and were timed in 18:26 and 18:33. Fritz took 33 seconds off his best time on the course from last year. Rylan dropped his time by a "Jaw-Dropping" 2 and half minutes. Simply Amazing. All the best at the WB-6 Conference Meet, Men and then get ready to run for some "Hardware" at the Sterling 09/JV Invitational on Tuesday, October 21st. After that, it will be time to help lead the Geneseo "Hype Squad". We are Very Proud of both of you. Thanks for being such great guys too.

Closing out the Leaf action on the day were Sophomore Cole Henson (121st place and timed in 19:49), Sophomore Noah Arnold (169th Place timed in 21:10), and Freshman Phoenix Sottos (200th place timed in 25:20). Each man raced Metamora's Black Partridge Park for the first time. Great Job, Men. Each of you have progressed nicely during the course of the season. All the best at the WB-6 Conference Meet on Thursday. That meet should be a LOT of Fun. Pretty cool that GHS is hosting the meet. After that you will have one more race to run. The Sterling 09/JV Invitational on Tuesday, October 21st. After that we hope that you will jump on board the "Geneseo Hype Squad" and help inspire the GHS Varsity Top 7 to great success during the IHSA Series. We hope that all three of you will plan to be with us again in the fall of '26. Well Done, Men.

The Varsity Boys Race was the final race on the day and what a race it was. The Starter's pistol fired at 11:25 a.m. sharp. Senior Leader Jaxson Sottos led the Leafs. He barely missed an individual "Top 30" spot with his 34th place finish. He was timed in a quick 15:50 (tying Henley's time.) His time moved him into the #5 GHS Senior position. He is already sitting in 3rd All-Time for any grade level with his 15:26 run at the Sectional Meet last fall. Jaxson is running a plethora of "Senior Pride" and appears ready lead the Leafs into "Championship Meet Season". The team has some lofty goals and appears ready to attack them. All the best. Carpe diem!!!

Fellow Senior Leader Graysen Carlson was the next man up for the Leafs and really went out HARD. He paid dearly for that experiment but now knows what happens when you cross the "Red Line". He still ended up running 16:28. and placed 65th overall in a strong Varsity field. His time moved him into the 12th fastest GHS Senior EVER on the course. His personal best on the course of 16:11 run at last year's Sectional meet has him placed in 11th All-Time. Great Stuff Graysen. Omnipotent levels of both Passion and Purpose are visible in you on a daily basis. Keep up the good work. The best way to lead is via example and no one does it better. Get ready to move into "Championship Meet Season". All the best. Keep Dreaming BIG!

Next up for the Maple Leafs was Senior Leader Aidan Bries. Aidan ran a great race and was "clocked" in 16:41. That time moved him into 13th place on the GHS Senior Top 25 list for the course. He placed 85th in the loaded field. Aidan just missed his personal best on the course (16:30 set at last falls Sectional Meet.) Next up will be the Western Big 6 Conference Championship which will be held at Geneseo's Richmond Hill Park on Thursday, October 16th. All the best in the Conference meet and beyond Aidan. You are a special young man and we greatly appreciate everything that you have given this team. Keep "Driving the Bus". "State Meet Fever".....CATCH IT!!!

Senior Leader Kaden Elmer was the 4th Maple Leaf to cross the finish line. He placed 146th in the talented field and was timed in 17:41. He didn't have his best race of the season but fear not....Kaden is always at his best when it matters the most. That is "Championship Meet Season". Kaden's time was still good enough to place him #24 on the GHS Senior Top 25 list for the course. His personal best of 16:40 (Sectional meet last year) currently sits in 22nd place. Kaden has had an impressive GHS career and it is going to be a LOT of fun watching him chase his potential in the coming weeks. All the best Kaden. It has been a true honor to serve as one of your coaches. Thank you for always being such a great guy. God Bless.

Junior Micah Johnson was the 5th and final "scorer" for the Maple Leafs. He placed 227th in the talented field and was timed in 19:24 which was just off of his personal best of 18:58 on the course. Next up will be the WB-6 Conference Meet on Thursday, October 16th. The Leafs are hosting the meet at Richmond Hill Park and are hoping to be in the hunt for the conference title. After that, Micah will have one final race this season at Sterling 09/JV Invitational on Tuesday, October 21st. Coach Ehlert has nicknamed that meet "JV STATE". It is a great way to end the season. After that it will be time to jump on board the GHS "Hype Squad" and help to inspire the Varsity Top 7 during the IHSA Post-Season. Next year you will be one of the team's Senior Leaders. Don't wait until then to start leading. Keep Dreaming BIG!!!

First year man Jameson Coppejans was the next Leaf to cross the finish line. The Senior Leader placed 237th and was timed in 19:35. He was the Varsity's 6th Man. Great Stuff "Jamo". It has been a LOT of Fun watching you improve during the course of the season. The WB-6 Conference meet is up next (Thursday) at Home. Hopefully, the Leafs are going to be in the middle of the team battle. The "Right" words or actions just might make the difference. After that you will also be racing at "JV State" in the Sterling 09/JV Invite on Tuesday, October 21st. After that YOU will be helping to drive the GHS "Hype Squad". Next up for the Maple Leafs was Senior Leader Cavin Bell. The 4-Year Harrier was "Clocked" in 20:31 and placed 264th in the talented field. Calvin has two more competitive efforts "on deck" for the Maple Leafs. He will toe the line on Thursday, October 16th at Richmond Hill Park when the team plays host to the WB-6 Conference Meet. After that his final race as a GHS Harrier will be on Tuesday, October 21st in the Sterling JV Invite (JV State.) After that, we hope that you will be an active member (leader) of the GHS "Hype Squad". The group attends all of the IHSA Meets (Regional, Sectional, State) and helps to inspire their teammates who are racing (Top 7

only.) It has been a Lot of fun watching you mature over the last 4 years. All the best in your remaining meets and beyond.

The final two Maple Leafs on the day were GHS Juniors Jacob Berry and Connor Runty who sprinted home in 20:46 and 20:51 respectfully. They placed 272nd and 276th overall in the talented field. They will also be racing in the WB-6 Conference Championship this Thursday (October 16th) at Geneseo's Richmond Hill Park. GO LEAFS. After that, their final race of the season will take place the following Tuesday (October 21st) at Sterling in their annual 09/JV Invite. After that, get ready to make some noise with the Geneseo "Hype Squad". Try and be a "Difference Maker". After that it will be time to start moving into the roll of Senior Leader for the 2026 season. We have complete confidence in each of you. Remember, the best way to lead is via example. Thanks for being such great guys. All the best men.

When the "Dust had Settled" the Varsity Team found themselves in 16th place. When you factor in that all of the GHS freshmen and sophomores ran in the F/S race that is pretty dang impressive.
