VARSITY PLACES 9TH

On Saturday, September 27th, the Leafs traveled to Sterling's Hoover Park to participate in the annual Rock River Cross Country Invitational. The meet included teams from: Belvidere, Belvidere North, Cambridge (Co-Op), Dixon, Eastland, Freeport, Geneseo, Geneva, Kaneland, LaSalle-Peru, Morrison, Ottawa, Peoria Richwoods, Princeton, Rochelle, Rock Falls, Rock Island, Sandwich, Sterling, Sterling (Newman) Sycamore, & Yorkville. The teams were treated to an amazing day weather-wise. The daytime high was in the 80's with the Varsity race time temperature in the 60's. The course was hard and fast and the dew point was in the 50's.

Several of the Leafs Top 7 were competing in the F/S Division later in the meet. Thus, the Varsity team wasn't full-strength. The Maple Leafs are still "Flying under the radar" as far as the Illinois State XC media is concerned. It should also be pointed out that the course for this meet was changed last year from 3 miles to 5k. Thus, all of the Top 25 lists had to be scrapped and we had to start over. Bummer. On a positive note, the individual medals number returned to 30 after dropping to 15 last year.

On to the racing. The Varsity Boys race took off at 9:35 sharp. Senior Leader Jaxson Sottos led the way and ran as the first GHS Senior for the course (he already has the 2nd fastest time ever for a Maple Leaf of any grade from last year...16:24.) He placed 19th overall and earned a highly prized "Top 30 Finisher Medal". Great stuff, Jaxson. Championship meet season is just around the corner. Get ready to FLY!.

Next up was Senior Leader Graysen Carlson who sprinted across the finish line in 36th place, barely missing "Hardware". He was timed in 17:26 which moved him into 4th on the All-Time GHS Top 25 list and into 3rd for GHS Seniors. Great Racing, Graysen. Your desire is on display every time you "Lace em up". Senior Leader Aidan Bries continued his bounce back after battling illness and injury for the last several weeks. He placed 48th overall and was timed in 17:39. Junior Drum Major Connor Runty was the final Maple Leaf to sprint across the finish line. He was timed in 22:18 and placed 150th overall in the race. 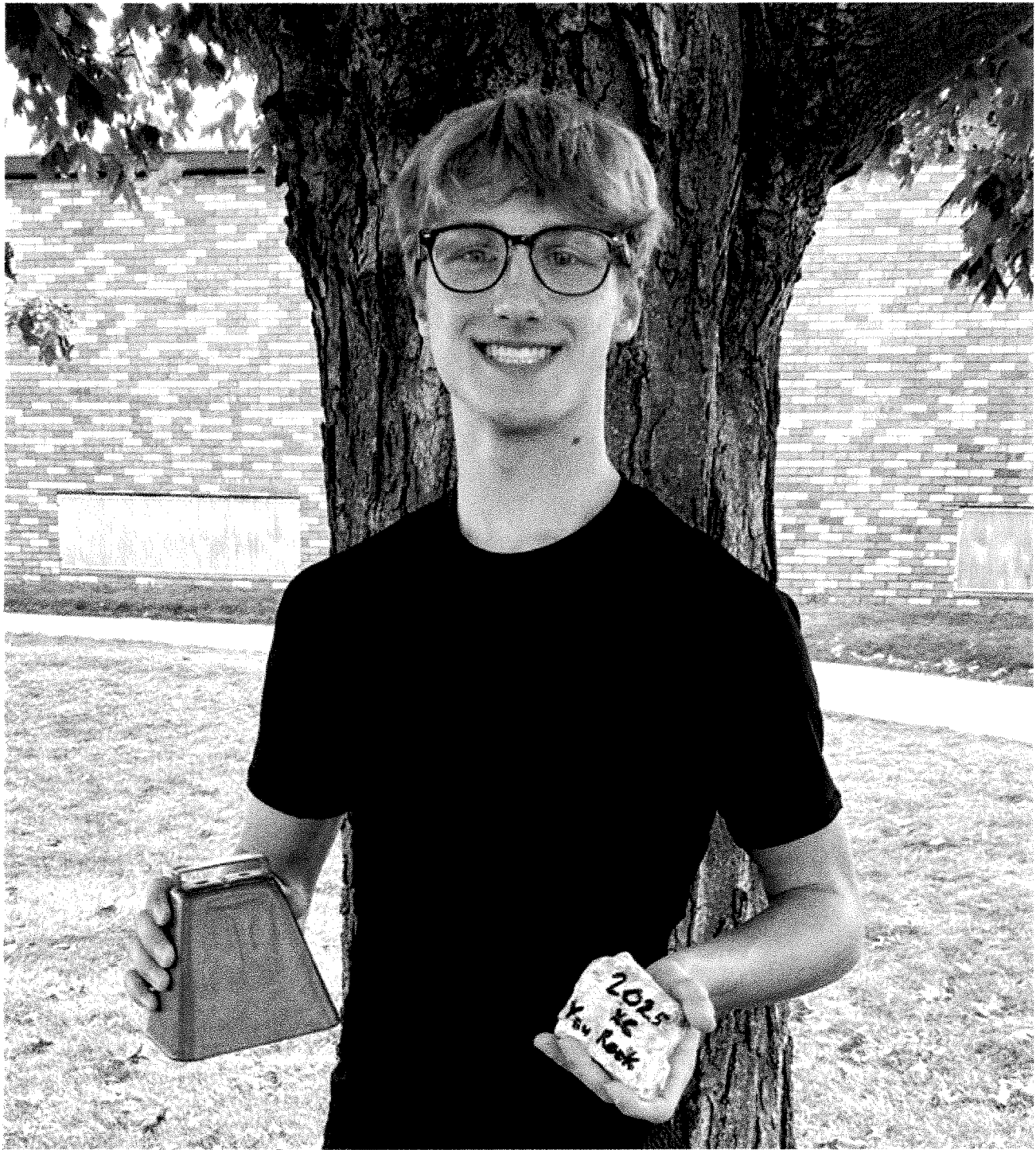

His rolled throught the first mile in a quick 6:11. He hit his 2nd mile in 6:45 and was feeling the effect of going out so fast. He held on nicely and "closed" his race with a 6:58 3rd mile. This is Jameson's first year with the team. I remember Coach Ehlert speaking about him last summer. He was very excited about Jameson's decision to join the team. There is certainly a significant learning curve to this sport. Knowledge is gained during each and every practice and race. It is especially rewarding to watch each man figure out how to get the most out of their races. Jameson had a BIG DAY on Saturday when he DESTROYED his personal best by a ton. He dipped below 21:00 minutes for the first time (7:00 minute pace). He ran 20:39. Keep your eyes on him. He isn't done there. He just "Kicked the Door Down" to a new found level of performance. We sure are glad that Jameson decided to "Give it a Try". He has been a great addition to the team. He brings a positive attitude and endless energy to practice on a daily basis. He has also make his impact as a "Senior Leader". Keep up the good job, Jameson. All the best in the coming weeks. We are Very Proud of You.

Here is what Jameson had to say about his athletic history.

12th Grade: "I joined Cross Country after a year of saying I would join, and boy let me tell you, I'm glad I did. It's a scary leap between 800m to 3 miles but it is one competition I strive to thrive in. Lastly, if you are on the edge of joining Cross Country do it. I love getting to know this sport and push past my limits (for example, a minute PR).".

11th Grade: "I did Track again and realized I like the competitive and social aspects".

10th Grade: "I finally started running long distances to socialize with friends and realized fast that it was hard and a fun challenge I wanted to do".

9th Grade: "I wrestled again in high school and found out I didn't like to hurt others".

8th Grade: "I thought my life would be nothing more than wrestling, I started dominating the mat and got a crazy growth spurt."

7th Grade: "I was a sloppy runner in Track and Field. I sadly chose sprinting and failed."

Prior to 7th grade: "I wrestled in 6th grade and broke my arm in a dramatic match, I later wrestled in another match pushing through the pain, before my last match my coach realized that something was wrong then subbed me out. I sadly didn't wrestle another match that day."

Jameson is the proud son of Katie and Patrick Coppejans. He is also the proud "Big Bro" to Elijah Coppejans who is a current Sophomore in High School.
