1. Your progress will be assessed using a variety of formats. Scores will be based on the amount of possible points you earn for each assessment.
2. At the end of each quarter, I will calculate the percentage of points you earned out of all possible points possible that quarter. This percentage, based on the GMS grading scale, will determine your quarter letter grade.
3. The semester grade will be the average of the two quarter letter grades based on the GMS grading scale.
4. Work will be accepted up to 2 days late. There may be a 20% deduction on work turned in up to 1 day late. You may receive $\frac{1}{2}$ credit for work turned in up to 2 days late. No credit may be given for work more than 2 days late.
