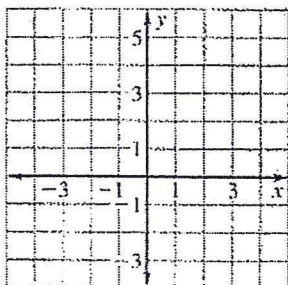

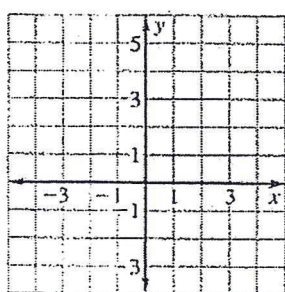
1. $x + y = 3$
